INTERESTING FACTS:

Race Name, Dates, and Distances

This race underwent many title changes as well as changes in distance. In the late 70s, SARR presented this race in December as the last run of the calendar year combining it with a Christmas Celebration

1976 had two races at Mission County Park: Oct. 2-10 Mile Horizon '76 Run; December 11-Remember the Alamo 20K Run. Note the differences in distance.

1977: Again two races held, both at Mission County Park. Oct. 1- Sidewinder 10 Mile Run; Dec. 10-Branding Iron 10k Run

1979: The November, 1979, Newsletter lists this as "SAARC Annual 10 Mile Run" but results an annual SARR schedule listed it as Mission Trails 10 Mile Run.

1983 also had two races: Dec. 10 – Descent Star Test 10k at Salado Creek Park, Ft. Sam Houston and Dec. 17- Mission Road 20k at Mission County Park.

2009: For this history, this race is listed as being held at Mission County Park. The last SARR Newsletter was published in August, 2009. No race info and/or entry form for that year is available.

2010 and 2012: Race started/ended at Mission County Park. Park of the route used Graham Trail, a new trail that connected Mission County Park with Mission San Jose. Once exiting Graham Trail, the runners went through the Mission. Special permission to run on the Mission grounds was obtained from the National Park Service and the Priest at Mission San Jose.

The races that went through Mission San Jose proved challenging for the organizers because of rules and regulations of the National Park Service and the Mission. No water stops on the grounds of the Mission; no directional signs, either posted or placed in ground; no loud music. Additional volunteers were needed to direct the runners in and out of the Mission grounds. As the runners entered the grounds through the double, wooden gates of the grounds (facing Roosevelt Street), they faced the front of San Jose Mission. It was a unique, beautiful site.

Email (June 2, 2011) from Walter Stoneham, RD 1978-1982: "Also, my 1981 10 miler was a unique event. Lowell (Duke) Embs, Chief agent of the local Connecticut Mutual office, paid for and delivered everything. He even helped with the tacos and drinks."

T-Shirt Designs

In the early years of this race, t-shirt designs were by Rosi Bustamante. Rosi created the majority of SARR t-shirt designs in the early years.

In 2012, Carol Baltutis, Paul Baltutis' wife, created the design. Jerry Negrete, SARR President at that time, submitted the shirt along with others to the RRCA National T-Shirt Design Competition. One of the criteria was that the shirt was to have the RRCA logo. The shirt took first place in the contest!!!! The shirt was long, sleeve blue, with a tree ornament on the front, pocket side, of the shirt. The back of the shirt had a Christmas tree made of snowflakes, an orange roadrunner in the middle, and all the tree ornaments had not only the RRCA logo but logos of the race sponsors. In 2013, the same design was used except the shirt was red and, of course, names of race sponsors changed. See attachments for a picture of the shirt.

San Antonio's Mission Trails 10-miler has built up a loyal following among Central Texas runners familiar with the race. It has come to be known as "the best cheap run in the world" and as "the sausage run." The epithets, of course, are derived from the fact that there is only a \$2.00 entry fee and there's plenty of tasty, spicy sausage to gorge yourself on after the race. The race is also unique in that the course contains wooden suspension bridges that must be crossed. This race is probably one of the state's most history-oriented runs because the 10-mile route passes by San Antonio's centuries-old Spanish missions: Missions Concepcion, Espada, San Jose, and San Juan Capistrano. San Jose, called the "Queen of the Missions, is a national historic site famous for its "rose window." These four missions, built between 1720-1731, lie south of the city's most

famous mission, The Alamo, built in 1718 as the San Antonio de Valero Mission by Spanish explorers. Later renamed the Alamo, the restored Roman Catholic mission is a hallowed shrine to Texas Independence won in 1836 with the blood of 187 defenders who were felled by Mexican soldiers.

The city boasts dozens of places of contemporary interest for visiting runners. The most popular spot is El Paso del Rio (The River Walk) that meanders serenely through palms and cypress trees and under arched cobblestone bridges 30 feet below bustling downtown streets above. Lining the sidewalks along each side of the canal are hotels, pubs, boutiques,

cafes, craft and gift shops.

Other interesting places to visit are the San Antonio Zoological Gardens and Aquarium, the nation's third largest zoo; HemisFair Plaza with its fascinating view of Texas history and culture on display at the Institute of Texan Cultures and the 750-foot tall Tower of the Americas; Market Square with its farmer's market and El Mercado featuring imports from across the border; and the Lone Star Beer Brewery, featuring Hall of Homs, Heidelberg Beer Garden, and the Buckhom Bar. KEYS TO THE COURSE

DESCRIPTION: Mostly flat with a couple of "easy" hills

SURFACE: Asphalt


AID STATIONS: Water or ERG at five-mile point if weather is warm. COURSE SUMMARY: The start/finish of this run is two blocks from well-known Mission San Jose in Mission County Park south of downtown. Most of the race is run on "low traffic volume" asphalt streets. Mile seven through eight is run on an asphalt bicycle path with two short wooden suspension bridges. (Runners should use caution while crossing the bridges.) Traffic control is provided at appropriate places and course marshals are stationed at crucial points.

All turns (comers) are clearly marked with flourescent paint. The course winds through various areas—parks, business, cemetery, airport, residential, and semi-rural. The halfway point is the historic Mission

Espada.


Participants begin the race on Padre, head south to S.E. Military, go under the street and turn right up the "short cloverleaf," then turn left onto Military and run along the shoulder facing traffic to Mission Road.



The course then takes a quick right onto Espada Road and runners go all the way to the Espada Mission, circle around the back of the mission, go down the hill and across the low-water crossing and up to Villamain.


Runners take a left onto Villamain, run to Ashley (it merges with Villamain), proceed across the bridge and turn right onto the bike path just across the bridge. Take the bike path to where it crosses the road at the dam. Then run the road under S.E. Military and back to the finish via Padre Drive.

A Bit of History.... The Mission 10 Miler

Thank you to Ernie Oaks for the Historical look back and to Sally Rios for her story .

March 13, 1976 - Heritage '76 10 Mile Run - Mission County Park. Listed in the description "This is your first chance to run the Mission Trail".

October 2, 1976 - Horizons '76 10 Mile Run - Mission County Park

December 11, 1976 - "Remember the Alamo" 20K - Mission County Park

March 12, 1977 - Pony Express 10 Mile - Mission County Park - "this is your opportunity to become familiar with the route that will be used for the Fiesta Mission Run, April 23rd."

October 1, 1977 - Mission Trails 10 Mile Run - Mission County Park

November 5, 1977 - Mavericks Mini-marathon 13.5 Miles - Mission County Park

December 10, 1977 - Branding Iron 10 Kilo Run - Mission County Park "For more information: ERNIE OAKES", yep I directed that one.

December 9, 1978 - 10K (6.2 mile) Run "SCHLITZE LITE" EVENT - Mission County Park

December 8, 1979 - SARRC Annual 10 Mile Run - Mission County Park - SHOULD BE THE FIRST of the current continuing Mission 10 Milers, note the "Annual" in the title.

December 13, 1980 - Mission Trails 10 Mile Event - Mission County Park

Interestingly the Mission Trails 10 Mile Run held on December 11, 1982 was followed by the Dannon 20K Run on December 18, 1982 with both being SARR events and the 20K of course funded by Dannon Yogurt.

Thoughts from Sally Rios:

I remember doing the Dannon 20K. It may have been one of my first long runs. I ran with my friend, Val Escobedo, who worked at SAC and was probably the impetus to getting me into running. She and I were newbees at running. We were probably the last runners. I remember that all marshals and water stop personnel were gone. Val's husband somehow knew which way we were going; would drive to the next turn; and point us in the right direction. At one point, we ran along the river (probably near Mission County Park 1). I had never been on that route and asked Val, "Are you sure we are still in San Antonio?" We finished but I don't remember anything about the finish area.






