## **SARR CPR Certification Class Policy**

- 1. All RRCA certified coaches who coach any SARR training program will have a Current CPR/First Aid/AED certification on file with the Director of Coaches.
- 2. All volunteers (certified coach or non-coach adult volunteer) who are added to the Coaching team of any Kids Run SARR training program will have a current CPR/First Aid/AED certification on file with the Director of Coaches.
- 3. As long as SARR has at least one CPR/First Aid/AED certified instructor as a club member, CPR/First Aid/AED classes on an as-needed basis to all SARR member RRCA certified coaches at a reduced cost (to be determined as the cost of processing fees and supplies to SARR in holding class).
- 4. SARR members who are RRCA certified coaches will pay for their initial CPR/First Aid/AED certification at SARR cost (if being certified at a SARR-hosted class).
- 5. SARR members who are RRCA certified coaches may re-certify their CPR/First Aid/AED free of charge in a SARR-hosted class if they have coached in a SARR training program for at least two (2) seasons in the last calendar year.
- 6. SARR members who volunteer to be on the coaching team of a Kids Run SARR training program, as either RRCA certified coaches or non-coach volunteers, will be provided with free CPR/First Aid/AED certification at a SARR-hosted CPR class prior to being added to a SARR youth training program.
