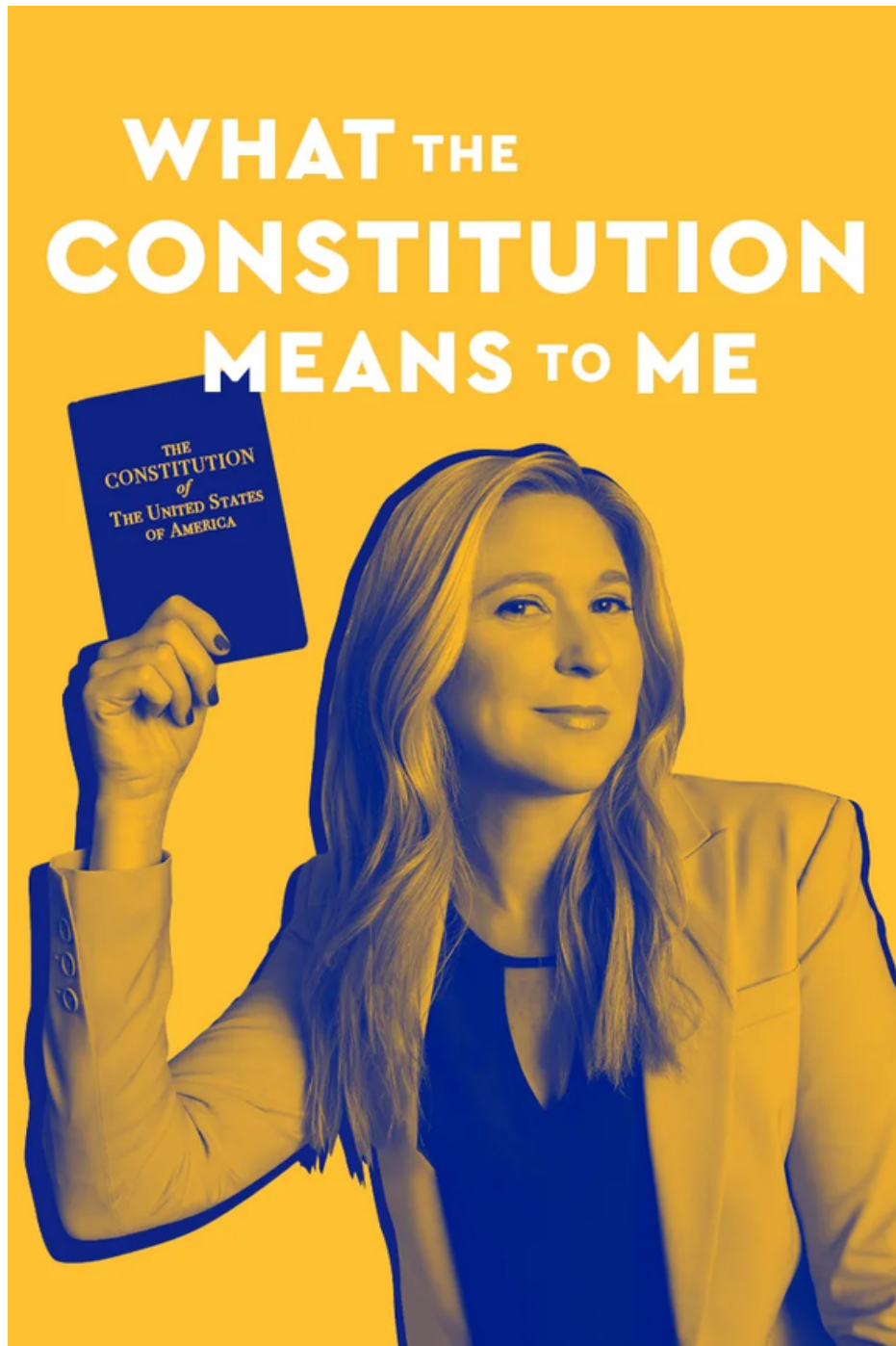

- This show includes themes of violence against women and rape.
- This is a list of possible sensory impacts you may experience while viewing this performance. Part of the magic of live performance is that unexpected things happen, so not every moment can be accounted for.
