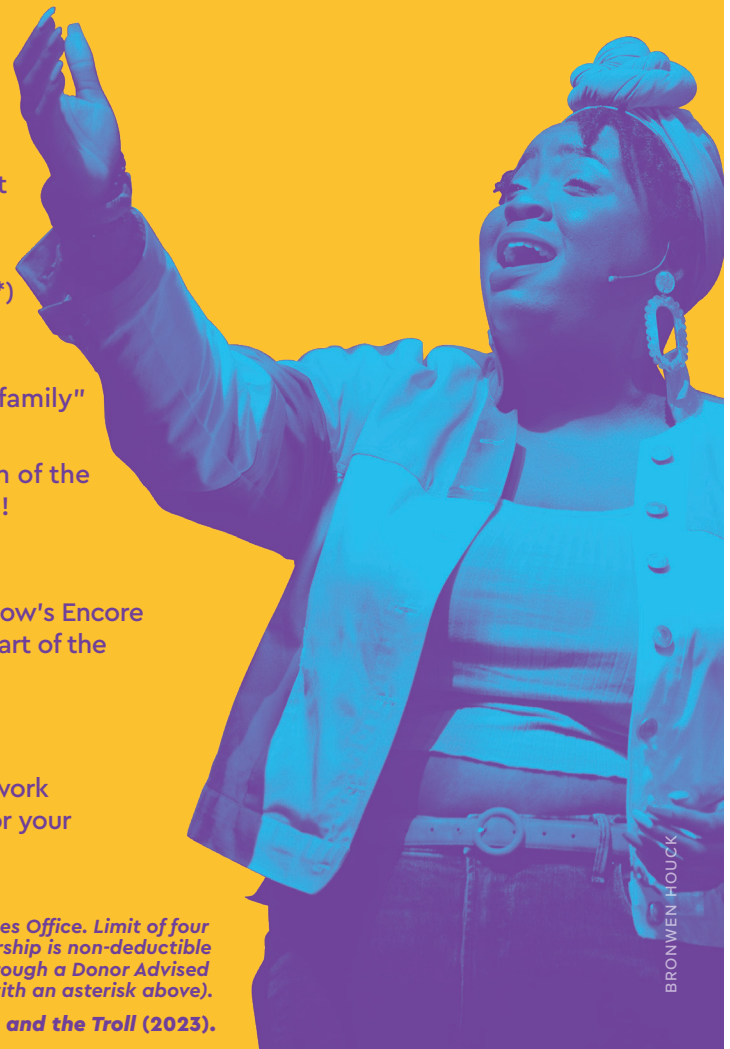
Enjoy Prominent Recognition
