
### SOLUTION

### HOW IT WORKS

We will introduce the Wild Ever After through press and our social platforms in order to increase visibility and sequentially generate donations. At the launch time the website will have 8 stories available, but only two will be unlocked in full wilderness mode for everyone to try out. Two donating options available are: a one-time payment to unlock 6 more stories with full wilderness content and a monthly subscription combining all available stories including the upcoming ones, audio content and printable coloring book featuring our wildlife characters.

With this tales concept we can use all the nature's habitants and purposedly avoid communicating usual 1-2 likeable animals for donations. Users donate to Rewilding Europe as organization trusting their expertise to decide where the money should go. The entire project can be done in partnership with a publisher recognising the possibility to cause wide outreach, emotionally strike and inspire as many people as possible.


