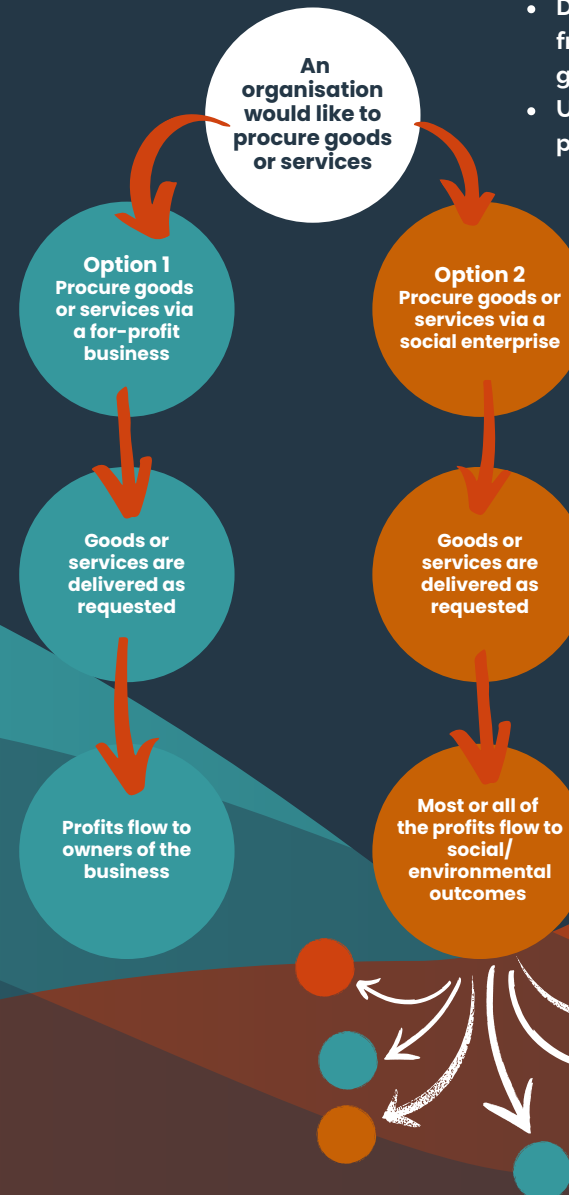
Social procurement

Social procurement is when organisations use their buying power to generate social value above and beyond the value of the goods, services or construction being procured.

Social enterprises are businesses that:

- Trade intentionally to tackle social problems, improve communities, provide access to employment and training, or help the environment;
- Derive most of their income from trade, not donations or grants; and
- Use at least 50 per cent of their profits on their social mission.
