### Workshop Option No. 1: Change Management

Dr. Galsworth will share the many innovations she has designed into her own 5S approach. She calls it "operator-led visuality"—aka, Work That Makes Sense (WTMS)." Do not mistake WTMS for mere industrial housekeeping or workplace organization. WTMS is 5S-on-Steroids! Here are some of the points that will be covered.

- S1/SORT: Learn the real meaning of S1 and why so much is at stake when so-called junk is removed in the name of 5S. Learn how you can use S1 to re-frame, re-align, and re-invent the work culture—while you avoid the pitfalls of red-tagging.
- S2/SHINE: Do you use S2 to promote thinking? If not, chances are you just get neat and clean instead of exciting, visionary outcomes.
- S3/SAFETY. What does 5S/Safety mean and how far can you and your associates go on the journey to a visually safe work area?
- S4/SET IN ORDER. What do all those lines and labels really mean anyway? What are the ways to re-frame "setting things in order" so the process deepens and grows?
- S5/SUSTAIN. How do you put sustainment at the heart of the 5S process, instead of simply an audit based excercise in compliance.
