Acting Technique

Acting with the Whole Body

- **Workshop Opportunities:** Exploration of use of the entire body as expressive instruments, unlocking performances that are felt and communicated from head to toe.
- **Skills:**
 - Through physical exercises and improvisation, actors practice expressing
 - Character
 - Objective
 - Location
 - Inner action
- **Suggested Price:**
 - \$90 per 90-minute workshop.
 - \$115 per 90-minute workshop during peak season.

*Body Awareness (*Part of our Actor's Boot Camp Series)*

- **Workshop Opportunities:** Greater awareness of their own physical capabilities and their physical relationships with others.
- **Skills:**
 - Personal physical awareness
 - Spatial awareness and physical relationships
 - Physical effort factors
 - Size and shape factors
- **Suggested Previous Experience:** Students should have an understanding of their own muscular tension, how to use imagination to relax, and how to focus on specific tasks before they participate in this workshop. Additionally, they should have worked on building trust in themselves and in others beforehand.

Students will develop greater control and awareness of their bodies through focused exploration of effort, size, and shape dynamics. By tuning into their physical presence and engaging in partner and group exercises, they'll learn to build strong, intentional relationships on stage.

Character Development (*Part of our Actor's Boot Camp Series)

- **Workshop Opportunities:** Learning to build characters externally (physically) and internally.
- **Skills:**
 - Physically-based characters
 - Characters built through the inner self:
 - Purpose
 - Emotions
 - Personality
 - Relationships
 - Circumstances
- **Suggested Previous Experience:** Students should have previous experience working on focus, body awareness, sensory awareness, imagination, and language, voice and speech.
- **Suggested Price:**
 - \$90 per 90-minute workshop

Communication

- **Workshop Opportunities:** Learning to deepen relationships onstage and off through observation, listening, expression and collaboration.

- **Notes:** This can be developed into as many sessions as desired. If focus is on games and de-mechanizing the spectator, a single session is appropriate (although more are always recommended.) For doing actual Image Theatre work, a minimum of two sessions is required. This is not available during peak season.

Directing

The Role of the Director

- **Workshop Opportunities:** Learn how to create a clear and compelling vision for a theatrical production, shaping the interpretation of the script and guiding the creative team.
- **Skills:** Through scene analysis, collaboration exercises, and concept development, students will:
 - Explore how to unify design elements, performances, and staging to bring their artistic vision to life.
 - Understand and emphasize the director's role in shaping the story, tone, and overall aesthetic of a production, helping students develop their unique directorial voice.
