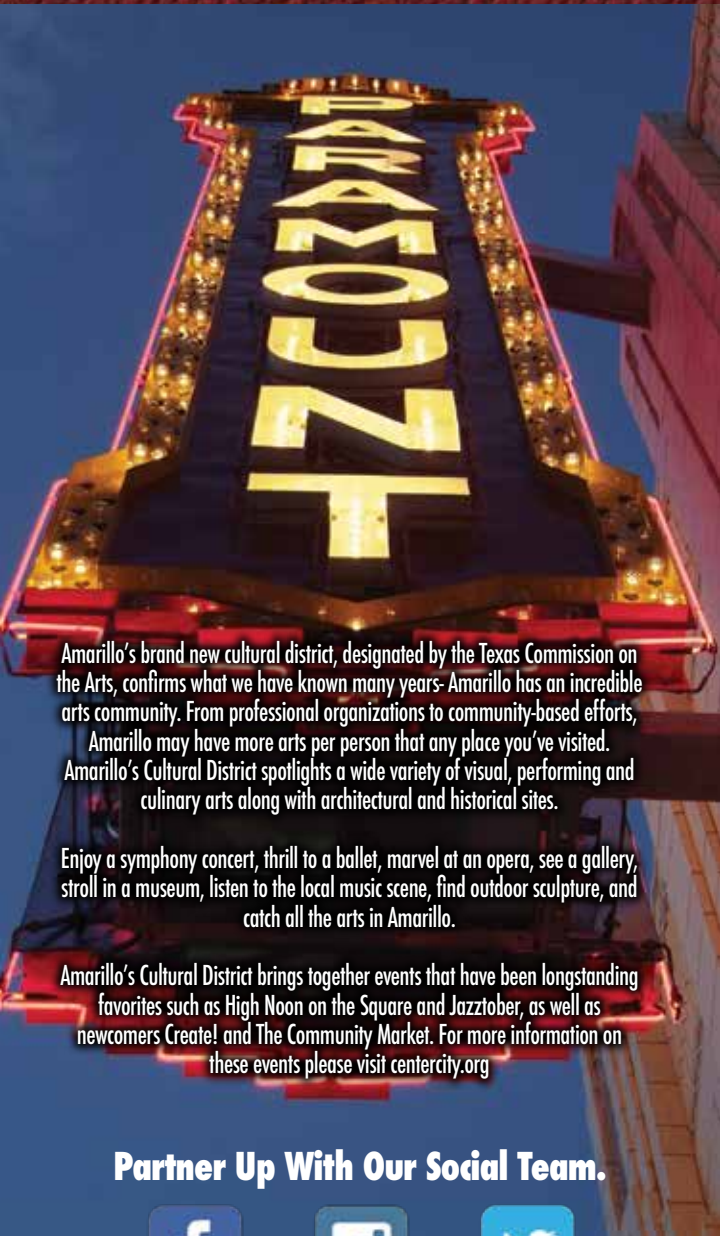

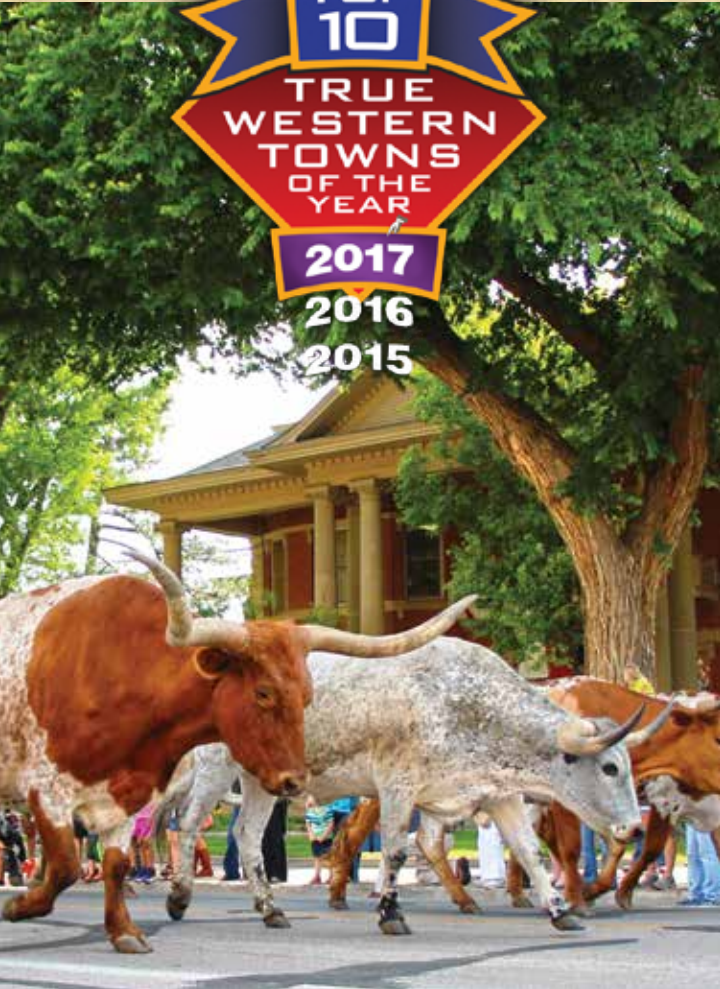

**Llano Cemetery** has been Amarillo's principal burying ground since the 1890s and many of the city's pioneer families are laid to rest here.
