Amarillo Climate/Weather

Amarillo enjoys a mild climate with four distinct seasons.

Summer temperatures are moderate due to our high altitude (3,676 ft.), with nights 25 to 30 degrees cooler than daytime highs. Humidity is wonderfully low and the breeze is constant. In the winter, our typically sunny skies raise average daily maximum temperatures to about 50 degrees, even in December, January and February.
