

Welcome to Augusta!

Training does not get much easier than coming to Augusta! In addition to 17 miles of calm, flat, rowable river through all four seasons, our facilities provide you the flexibility to train both on and off the water which will allow your program to continue training just like you were at home!



The Augusta Metro Area includes five counties for statistical purposes: Richmond, Columbia, Burke, McDuffie and Aiken counties, and is 306.5 square miles making it one of the largest cities by total area in the US. Metro-Augusta is the second largest metropolitan area in Georgia, after Atlanta, with a population of approximately 500,000 citizens. The Cost of Living Index for Augusta is 91 based on as US average of 100, meaning Augusta is 9% less expensive to reside in than the average US city.

Augusta's River Region

Beyond the city of Augusta lies a larger and more diverse area we refer to as Augusta's River Region, which encompasses the Savannah River and the neighboring cities including Augusta, Aiken, Columbia County, Edgefield and North Augusta.

Boasting pleasant summers and mild winters, Augusta is an excellent year-round destination. In the winter, the average high is $58.9~^{\circ}F$ ($14.9~^{\circ}C$) and the average low is $34.4~^{\circ}F$ ($1.3~^{\circ}C$). See below for a monthly breakdown of average temperatures in Augusta.

TRAVELING TO AUGUSTA

Augusta, Georgia is conveniently located along Interstate 20, approximately 150 miles east of Atlanta and 78 miles southwest of Columbia, South Carolina. It is easily accessible to most of the southeast US via its prime location on Interstate 20. The Savannah River serves as the state line and separates Augusta from North Augusta, S.C. Augusta is the second oldest and second largest city in Georgia and today stands as a center for medicine, the military, and manufacturing.
