<b>March 20</b>	Grant applications due.
<b>March 21-24</b>	Applications will be reviewed for completeness and to ensure compliance with the requirements. Applicants may be contacted at this time to provide additional information or clarification to their application.
<b>March 28</b>	Austin CVB Working Group will review and recommend to award based on tourism justification.
<b>April 10</b>	The Grants Committee of the Historic Landmark Commission, along with a representative from the Austin CVB, will review the ACVB Working Group's recommendations in a workshop. Historical justification will be the focus to recommend. Applicants highly encouraged to attend to answer any questions.
<b>April 24</b>	The Historic Landmark Commission will hold a public meeting to make final decisions on recommendations for the grant awards.
<b>April 26- May 5</b>	City of Austin Law Department will review applications recommended for award to confirm documentation of the benefit to tourism and that the use fits within the approved uses in the statute.
<b>May 8-12</b>	A summary report of all recommended grant awards will be reviewed by the City Manager's Office prior to award.
<b>May 15</b>	Grants are awarded by the Austin Convention and Visitors Bureau
