

# Welcome to Austin.

Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) is a state-of-the-art airport with 25 gates, full customs facilities ready for the international traveler, and two parallel runways including a 12,250-foot runway. Easy to get to (only seven and a half miles from the Austin Convention Center) and easy to get through, passengers enjoy exceptional customer service Austin-style, with 20+ live music performances each week, art exhibits and local food. In operation since 1999, the airport has roughly 350 daily flights with nonstop service to 65+ destinations. A record 12.4 million passengers traveled through ABIA in 2016.

ABIA is expanding nonstop flight service from several destinations including:

*Aeromexico from Mexico City (Nov. 2016)*

*Sun Country Airlines from Minneapolis/St. Paul (Aug. 2017)*

*Delta from Boston (Sep. 2017)*

*ViaAir from Steamboat Springs (Dec. 2017, seasonal)*

*Norwegian from London Gatwick (Mar. 2018)*

*Delta from Amsterdam (Mar. 2018, during SXSW only)*

*Vacation Express from Punta Cana (May 2018)*

Austin-Bergstrom International Airport was named the #16 Most Affordable U.S. Airport by Cheapflights.com (July 2015). The Austin airport made the list for the "World's Best Airports for Customer Service" in 2015, according to the Airports Council International, or ACI, which conducted the survey.

Norwegian announced new nonstop service between ABIA (AUS) and London Gatwick (LGW) three times weekly, beginning in March 2018.

Condor Airlines services nonstop flights between ABIA and Frankfurt International Airport (FRA) seasonally, Mondays and Thursdays from May - October.

The British Airways Dreamliner 787 flies daily between ABIA and London-Heathrow (LHR).

Fly from Toronto (YYZ) on Air Canada, daily.

The airport is adding a nine-gate terminal expansion and will also see the addition of a new Hyatt Place hotel.
