Endorsed Bloomington-Monroe County Bicentennial Programs and Projects receive:

- Listing on the 2018 Bicentennial website www.visitbloomington.com/bicentennial-2018
- Official Bicentennial Seal of Endorsement for use on your marketing materials
- Permission to use the official 2016 Bloomington and Monroe County Bicentennial logos, in accordance with the established logo guidelines, on Bicentennial related promotional materials
- Letter of endorsement from the Bloomington-Monroe County Bicentennial Committee
- Yard sign to post when project takes place

Endorsement Criteria

To be considered for endorsement by the Bloomington-Monroe County Bicentennial Committee, the applicant must demonstrate to the Committee's satisfaction that the proposed project meets the following required criteria and at least one of the recommended goals or characteristics outlined below. Priority will be given to projects that meet multiple goals.

All requests for endorsement must be submitted on the official Application for Endorsement

Projects or programs MUST be:

- Open and accessible to the public
- Relevant to Monroe County and/or Bloomington's bicentennial
- Fundable without Committee support
- Achievable

Projects or programs must also meet at least one of the following recommended goals or characteristics:

- Culturally inclusive
- Creating legacy for the future
- Celebratory
- Engaging and inspiring

Exclusion Clause

The Bicentennial Committee will not consider endorsing the following:

- Individuals (i.e. candidates for public office)
- For-profit ventures
- Political organizations

Application:

- Project title
- Target Audience
- Dates of Implementation
- Sponsoring Organization, website of organization
- Type of Organization
- Contact person: name, address, phone, email
- Verification that project is fundable without support from the Bicentennial Committee
- Project Description: Demonstrate how project meets endorsement requirements and provide a brief description of project
- Implementation: List community partners, sponsors, staff/volunteer involvement
- Specific benefits to the Bloomington and/or Monroe County Bicentennial: Culturally inclusive, Celebratory, Creates a lasting legacy for Bloomington's future, Engaging and Inspiring
- Include at least 1 but no more than 3 letters of support from community partners
- Include additional descriptive materials (if applicable)

The Endorsement Committee meet to bi-monthly (if there are applications to be endorsed) through November, 2018.
