The Chapel Hill Public Library at 100 Library Drive, will exhibit 30 "Vitamin O" portraits, each consisting of several photographs and an intriguing write-up about each subject displayed on a, 20 by 24 inch, framed print through the month of June. A joint project of Alicia Stemper and the Chapel Hill-Orange County Visitors Bureau, Vitamin O is designed to call attention to Orange County by telling the stories of the people who live, work, relocated or retired here.
