

Chattanooga is dedicated to continually enhancing the city, so you'll always find new events, music venues, attractions and restaurants popping up all over town.



Station Street

Station Street is Tennessee's newest entertainment destination at the Chattanooga Choo Choo. The pedestrianfriendly street is now an outdoor festival space and offers patio access to Songbirds Guitar Museum, The Comedy Catch, Terminal Brewhouse, Backstage Bar, Hush, Revelry Room, Frothy Monkey, and much more.

Enjoy a one and a half hour daytime cruise with a delicious lunch and commentary on river history, legends, & places! Or partake in the dinner cruises where true Southern hospitality prevails in the old riverboat tradition.

Where the **Southern Belle** docks, stop by the 3rd Deck Burger Bar. This hidden gem overlooking the Tennessee River has outside patio or indoor leather couch seating.

Chattanooga **Ducks**

More than just a ride, it's an adventure! Begin at the corner of 5th and Market where you will board an authentic WWII amphibious landing craft built specifically for the D-Day invasion. Chattanooga Adventures

There's a reason Chattanooga's been dubbed the "Best Town Ever" by Outside Magazine...twice. There are adventures around every corner and hidden inside mountains, just waiting for you and your family to escape the ordinary and explore.

Ruby Falls

Discovered in 1928, Ruby Falls gushes more than 1,120 feet below the surface of Lookout Mountain. It's the nation's largest and deepest underground waterfall open to the public, and definitely a unique experience.

The Lost Sea Adventure

America's largest underground lake lies below the surface near Sweetwater, TN. Visitors can tour the caverns, glide across the "Lost Sea" by boat, and even rough it on a Wild Cave Tour.



Raccoon Mountain

The caverns of Raccoon Mountain feature more than 5 miles of underground trails. Two different guided tours are offered: the Crystal Palace Tour for those interested in a more educational experience, and the Wild Cave Expedition for those who want to get down and dirty.

Cumberland Caverns

With more than 32 miles of caves to explore, Cumberland Caverns offers a varied experience with underground passageways, rock formations, waterfalls and more. From day trips to overnighters to bluegrass concerts, these caves have a ton going on that you don't want to miss.

Scenic City Encounters

Redefine family time with authentic experiences at Chattanooga's unique attractions



hattanooga's ability to entertain and inspire kids of all ages is just one reason the city has twice been named Outside Magazine's "Best Town Ever." Between boat rides, climbing walls, zip lines and more, Chattanooga is the best city for adventurous families.

After the water, take to the sky with Flying Camp, the area's only tandem paragliding flights, or plunge from the sky with Chattanooga Skydiving.

Afterward, head to Lookout Mountain where families can climb and fly through the trees together via the Ruby Falls ZIPStream zipline experience. For those that want to keep their feet on the ground, try horseback riding at the Tennessee Dude & Guest Ranch.

High Point Climbing and Fitness on Broad Street stands out among Chattanooga's cityscape with its outdoor climbing wall













affixed to the side of a parking garage. Inside, its Kids Zone has everything needed to keep the little ones happily occupied via kid-friendly climbing walls. But don't be fooled, these walls offer parents a real challenge too. Or ditch the climbing shoes for bowling shoes at Spare Time Entertainment or Pin Strikes.

Nearby **iGNiS Glass Studio** provides another unique experience, offering you the chance to mold molten glass into ornaments and souvenirs to take home to loved ones.

The Tennessee River flows right between the North Shore and downtown, and families can experience the water in several different ways, including renting stand-up paddleboards, canoes or kayaks. The whole family can paddle beneath the bridges for an intimate look at our biggest waterway.

For the truly extreme sports families, plan a day hang gliding at **Lookout Mountain** Flight Park. Inexperienced fliers as young as 4 years old can fly tandem, getting a bird's-eye view. There's also world-class whitewater rafting on the Ocoee River available with Cherokee Rafting, High Country, Ocoee Outdoors, Quest Expeditions and Outland Expeditions.

If you're looking for a theme park, Lake Winnepesaukah Amusement Park and Soak Ya Water Park is home to kiddie rides, family rides and thrill rides, as well as special seasonal events.

And of course, no family excursion is complete without a stop at the iconic MoonPie® General Store on Broad Street. After all that adventuring, a delicious MoonPie (or two, or three) is definitely in order.

Free for all to enjoy is the 13-mile long Tennessee Riverwalk that meanders along the beautiful scenery of the river. On any sunny day, you'll find locals walking, skating and biking from end to end.








Family Fun Itinerary

Relax! It's all here and it's all good. Enjoy four days of family fun in the Scenic City.



Day 1 Morning

Start your morning out with a trip to the **Chattanooga Zoo**. This ideal sized zoo for families is full of exotic animals, from chimpanzees and tarantulas to snow leopards, red pandas and more. After spending the morning indulging your wild side, head over to the North Shore for a quick and tasty lunch at local favorite **Taco Mamacita**, a modern mix of Mexican fare and American dining.

Afternoon

Creative Discovery Museum is a must stop for kids! Here thev can explore unique and educational play stations that are fun for the whole family at one of the nation's top children's museums.

Visit with animals that make their homes in the Southeast including a bobcat, crows, redtailed hawks, owls, vultures, bald eagle, flying squirrel and snakes at Reflection Riding Arboretum and Nature Center.

Day 2 Morning

This day is all about legendary Chattanooga. Start out at Rock **City,** where unique, accessible trails lead to a gorgeous view from the top of Lookout Mountain. On a clear day, you can reportedly see seven surrounding states. Then, make the short drive over to Ruby Falls, where the family can venture underground for a good look at the largest and deepest underground commercial waterfall in the country.


Before you leave the mountain, be sure to stop at the **Incline** Railway and take the milelong rail car trip down the 72.7 percent incline, billed as one of the steepest passenger inclines in the world.

Afternoon

After all that exploring, you're sure to be hungry, so head over to Food Works on the North Shore for some delicious and progressive Southern fare. Finish with ice cream from **Clumpies** on Frazier Avenue. Enjoy your cone as you walk across the Walnut Street Bridge over the Tennessee River and catch a Chattanooga Lookouts minor league baseball game.

Day 3 Morning

Start out with breakfast at Puckett's, where you can pick from pancakes, omelets and more, all served in the heart of downtown.

After breakfast, walk the short distance from the restaurant to the

Tennessee Aquarium, where you can experience 10,000 animals in its Ocean and River exhibits. From encountering alligators to watching otters play to gawking at sharks, plan to spend a considerable amount of your day here, because there's so much to see and do.

If you've got a big Disney Mater fan in the group, drop by the **International Towing** and Recovery Museum for some educational entertainment. This unique museum tells the story of the towing and recovery industry worldwide with some of the oldest, fastest and largest tow trucks in the world.

Finally, finish up your day at the 3rd Deck **Burger Bar**, situated inside the Southern Belle Riverboat at


Ross's Landing. This restaurant is a sort of hidden gem, sitting 40 feet above the Tennessee River and featuring a menu that boasts a variety of excellent burgers.

Day 4

This day begins with shopping so you can memorialize your trip. Whether downtown or at **Hamilton Place** Mall, take some time to browse and buy some real finds.

Grab a quick lunch and dinner at one of the many restaurants near or in the mall before heading over to Sir **Goony's Family Fun** Center or Pin Strikes. These two Chattanooga landmarks feature mini-golf, bowling complete with vintage structures at each hole, as well as classic finds like an arcade, batting cages and bumper cars.


Today ends with an historic train ride on the **Tennessee Valley Railroad**, riding off into the sunset with sleepy, happy kids!















Really Romantic

hether vou're foodies, art lovers, outdoor types or urbanites, Chattanooga offers something for every romantic couple vacationing in the Scenic City.

Stroll the lovely **Bluff** View Art District, grabbing lunch or dinner at one of the local eateries nearby. Afterward, grab a cup of joe and some housemade chocolates at Rembrandt's Coffee **House.** You can either sit on the picturesque patio outside or take your treats on a walk to explore the public art on display in the district. The Hunter **Museum of American Art** is also a terrific place to explore, with its rotating art exhibits and picturesque views of the Tennessee River.

Across town, the Southside neighborhood serves as a fun and high-energy datenight destination. Start out by walking along



Main Street and checking out the charming shops and art galleries. Grab dinner at Alleia, or Alex Thai Food & Sushi Bistro and then make your way to Clyde's On Main for after-dinner drinks.



Spend a day playing in Coolidge and Renaissance Parks on the North Shore, where you'll find walking trails and sprawling fields that are perfect for picnics. Explore Frazier Avenue, home to an abundance of local shops and eateries. Wander across the **Walnut Street Bridge** for a unique view of downtown and a breath of fresh air high above the Tennessee River.

If you're looking for a thrilling and spooky adventure together, sign up for Chattanooga Ghost Tours and an experienced guide will lead you around the city while regaling you with local tales of mystery, horror and history.

If you're looking for some seriously good entertainment, check out the newly revamped Station Street by the Chattanooga Choo Choo.

Be sure and explore Chattanooga's entertainment district on Station Street. This cobblestone addition to Chattanooga's Southside includes multiple bars, restaurants and music venues.

Be sure to check these hotspots out and please drink responsibly.









History Unfolds Here


From the Trail of Tears to the Civil War, Chattanooga has a rich and diverse history that is evident in many of its popular attractions.

here did we get our name? The city actually started out with two different names - Ross's Landing and Lookout City. In 1838, the city officially became "Chattanooga," a Native American word meaning "rock coming to a point" that refers to Lookout Mountain.

Chattanooga's Native American history starts at Ross's Landing on the downtown riverfront. This area was established in 1816 by John Ross, the chief of the Cherokee Nation, and served as a trading post and ferry. In 1838, Cherokees left from Ross's Landing for Oklahoma on what became known as the Trail of Tears

Ross's Landing now has a public art memorial known as **The** Passage, where you can play in water cascading down steps alongside 6-foot clay medallions.


In 1817 the Brainerd Mission was established to educate and




instill Christian values in Cherokee Indian children. Today, you can visit the Brainerd Mission Cemetary — a Trail of Tears site where over 50 graves of missionary workers are laid to rest.

During the 1860's Civil War, Chattanooga was a strategic battleground because of the mountains, ridges, river and rail systems, an important location for both the Union and the









Confederate armies. Both General Sherman and General Grant were stationed in Chattanooga in 1863 and 1864.


Chickamauga-Chattanooga National Military **Park** is the oldest National Military Park and draws a million visitors a year that pay tribute to those that died. Nearby in the City of Chickamauga, more historic opportunities are available to explore.



Cancelling his surgery, Bob instead flew 300 miles to consult with Dr. Larry Shears, who operated later that week. Days later, Bob was feeling great, and almost fully recovered. Is it any wonder this seasoned tourism executive considers his quick trip to Chattanooga the most rewarding of his life?
