Come Ride the Trolley!

The Trolley's 31st season begins on Monday, May 7 with tours offered 7 days / week until late September.

The narrated historic tours take place **on weekdays** every 90 minutes (10 am, 11:30 am, 1 pm, 2:30 pm, 4 pm). These weekday tours include stops at several attractions along the way. Riders can get off the trolley, tour the attraction, and then re-board the trolley on its next tour. **On weekends**, the Trolley offers 2-hour tours (Saturdays at 10 am, 12 noon, 2 pm. Sundays 12 noon, 2 pm).

Trolley tickets are \$12 for adults and \$6 for children age 2-12. Visit Cheyenne also offers a *Trolley Plus ticket* for \$19 which includes the trolley ride plus admittance to three museums.
