Cumberland Valley is home to some of the finest agricultural land in Pennsylvania and the United States. One third of the County's land is considered "Prime Farmland" according to the Natural Resource Conservation Service.

Cumberland Valley Fast Facts:

- Cumberland County agriculture generates a total of \$129.5 M in cash receipts from the sale of agricultural crops and livestock products according to 2010 PA Agricultural Statistics.
- There are approximately 1,500 farms in varying sizes in the County.
- 156,000 acres (or 44%) of the County are in agricultural use.

Cumberland Valley's agriculture industry provides opportunities for residents and visitors to obtain local fruits, vegetables and other farm fresh products through our farmers markets, farm stands, CSAs and other retailers.

Benefits of Buying Local:

- Support a local economy and farms, keeping wealth within our region and creating jobs
- Higher nutrient levels retained in food and fuller flavor due to the foods reaching you faster
- Locally produced food is fresher than foods packed in trucks and shipped for several days

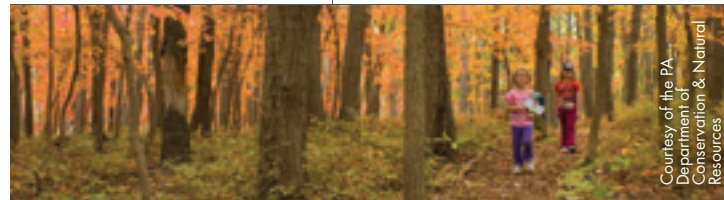

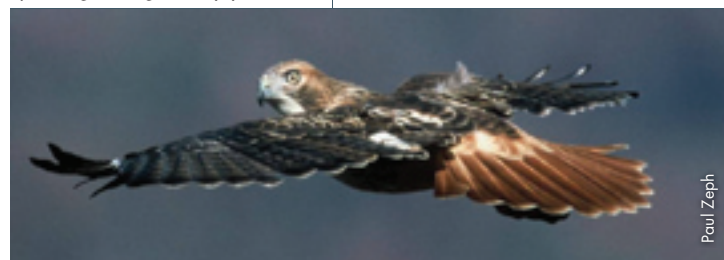
