DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. - (February 2018) - Visitors are discovering a new Daytona Beach - an exciting chapter in the destination's history showcasing its racing heritage, idyllic East Coast oceanfront location and impressive arts affiliation. With nearly **\$2 billion in renovations and construction**, the area's investments make for an even more exciting vacation stay for visitors. Accommodations Galore



The historic **Streamline Hotel**, an art deco-style property that once hosted the meeting that launched NASCAR - as well as an episode of Hotel Impossible opened in 2017 as an upscale beachside boutique property. The Hilton Daytona Beach Oceanfront Resort just completed a \$25 million renovation. The Delta by Marriott Daytona Beach opened in January and the new oceanfront Hard Rock Hotel Daytona Beach will open in March. Visitors will enjoy two planned hotels at ONE DAYTONA, world-class dining and entertainment complex across from the Daytona International Speedway, offering a total of 250 rooms. The 105-room Fairfield Inn & Suites Daytona Beach Speedway/Airport opened in January and will be followed by

an exclusive 145-room Marriott Autograph Collection® hotel called The DAYTONA, planned for late 2018. A new oceanfront Marriott Renaissance hotel just north of the Ocean Center Convention Center is being planned for 2019. The area is also home to several new properties that opened in the last two years including the **Residence Inn by Marriott** Daytona Beach Oceanfront, Hilton Garden Inn and the Chateau Mar Beach Resort boutique property.

The **Cici and Hyatt Brown Museum of Art**, a 26,000 square foot museum, opened in 2015 on the campus of the Smithsonian-affiliated **Museum of Arts and Sciences**. It is home to an extensive collection of more than 2,700 Florida oil and watercolor paintings, the largest private collection in the world. The mezzanine features a permanent gallery showcasing the collection's signature pieces. The Museum also includes six smaller, changing galleries, conference and education rooms, a café with outdoor seating and a gift shop. 'World Center of Racing' Reimagines an American Icon



Race fans are rejoicing over the <u>DAYTONA Rising</u> Project – a \$400 million overhaul that transformed **Daytona International Speedway** into the world's only motorsports stadium in 2016. This world-class facility with premium amenities and unparalleled conveniences has three concourse levels spanning the frontstretch; five expanded and redesigned fan entrances called 'injectors'; 11 social areas dubbed 'neighborhoods,' each the size of a football field with open sightlines and dozens of video screens to capture the on-track action; more than 60 new luxury trackside suites with patios; 17 elevators and 40 escalators in the grandstand; and, 101,500

new 20"-21" grandstand seats featuring backs and arm rests. In addition, more than 7,000 solar panels make this sports complex one of the top five largest solar installations at a professional sports venue in the country.
