

What's new with attractions, accommodations, dining and more at the 'World's Most Famous Beach'

DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. – (March 23, 2018) – From endless activities to calm, quiet days spent sunbathing and beachcombing, visitors are finding just what they're looking for in a Florida vacation along the 23 miles of world-famous shores of <u>Daytona Beach</u>. With area investments of more than **\$2 billion** in progress and more hotel, attraction, dining and shopping options available, it's a great time to experience all that Daytona Beach has to offer, including:

- ONE DAYTONA, a multi-million dollar world-class entertainment destination opened across from Daytona International Speedway with dining, retail and entertainment along with new hotels.
- **Hard Rock Hotel Daytona Beach**, opened in March 2018 with 200 rooms on the oceanfront.
- Daytona Beach Convention Hotel and Condominium, a \$192 million, 501-room oceanfront complex is under construction just north of the Ocean Center convention center complex.

More About Accommodations

The new 200-room oceanfront Hard Rock Hotel Daytona Beach opened in March 2018 and the 133-room Delta by Marriott Daytona Beach opened in January. The 744-room Hilton Daytona Beach Oceanfront Resort completed a \$25 million renovation. ONE DAYTONA, a world-class dining and entertainment complex across from the Daytona International Speedway, includes two hotels - the 105-room Fairfield Inn & Suites Daytona Beach Speedway/Airport opened in January, and the exclusive 145-room Marriott Autograph Collection® hotel called The DAYTONA, will open in late 2018. The 107-room Home2 Suites by Hilton is under construction in the area just east of the Speedway, and a new oceanfront, 4-Diamond Marriott Renaissance hotel is being planned just north of the Ocean Center Convention Center. The 44-room Streamline Hotel, a historic beachside art deco-style boutique property that once hosted the meeting that launched NASCAR, opened in 2017. Others recently added include the Residence Inn by Marriott Daytona Beach Oceanfront, Hilton Garden Inn and the boutique Chateau Mar Beach Resort.

Direct flights and interstate access (I-95 and I-4) make getting to Daytona Beach easy and convenient. Non-stop flights from New York City (JetBlue), Atlanta (Delta) and Charlotte (American Airlines) — with hundreds of connecting flights makes Daytona Beach the perfect beach base camp to experience Central Florida.

ONE DAYTONA is a world-class retail, dining and entertainment destination located directly across from Daytona International Speedway. Cobb Daytona Luxury Theatres, Bass Pro Shops Outpost, Guitar Center, IT'SUGAR, P.F. Chang's, Jeremiah's Italian Ice, Oklahoma Joe's BBQ, Rock Bottom Restaurant & Brewery, MidiCi: The Neapolitan Pizza Company, Ben & Jerry's and more have opened to rave reviews with additional retail and dining coming soon. ONE DAYTONA includes two hotels totaling 250 rooms – the Fairfield Inn & Suites Daytona Beach Speedway/Airport opened in January and an exclusive Marriott Autograph

Collection® hotel called **The DAYTONA** is planning to open in late 2018. With live entertainment and unique dining and retail options, ONE DAYTONA is quickly becoming a favorite place for visitors, race fans and residents alike.

New Restaurants, Culinary Treasures and Brews Abound

The area's <u>culinary scene</u> is experiencing a growing number of exciting, new offerings – from off-the-beaten-path eateries and independent restaurants serving specialty fare, to oceanfront dining and entertainment complexes. From casual family fare to fine dining, the Daytona Beach area offers many culinary treasures. With nearly two dozen local breweries, tasting rooms and tap houses to explore, the <u>Daytona Beach Ale Trail</u> provides a unique way to taste Florida craft beer. The Copper Bottom Craft Distillery offers artisan hand-crafted spirits, tours and tastings.



Shopping and Travel Go Together



Whether you want to shop 'til you drop or explore unique markets and boutiques, the Daytona Beach area offers lots of options. **Tanger Outlets** is an open-air center with 75 of the most popular national brand name and designer outlet stores. On International Speedway Boulevard is **ONE DAYTONA**, the new retail, dining and entertainment district, and the long-popular **Volusia Mall** which provides an inviting indoor experience. The area's **five thriving downtown districts** - Daytona Beach, Ormond Beach, New Smyrna Beach and DeLand (voted **America's Main Street** in 2017) continue to add

eclectic, new boutiques and eateries. Exceptional flea and farmers markets can also be found throughout the area.

'Festival Capital of Florida' - Fabulous Food and Fun

From arts and culinary to classic cars and motorcycles, the Daytona Beach area celebrates a multitude of interests with its <u>events and festivals</u>. Comfortable year-round weather means it's always festival season with events like the Halifax Art Festival, Celtic Festival, Oyster Festival, Greek Festival, DeLand Festival of the Arts, Images: A Festival of the Arts, Fiesta Italiana, Granada Grand Festival of the Arts, Riverfest Seafood Festival and the annual Daytona Turkey Run car show and swap meet in both spring and fall. The Country 500 kicks off the summer season with a three-day music festival at Daytona International Speedway over the Memorial Day Holiday.





Biketoberfest (Oct. 18-21, 2018)



Biketoberfest® annually celebrates the adventure and the spirit of today's motorcycle enthusiast. This isn't just any motorcycle rally and with a guest list of 100,000 it is the area's largest fall festival. Main venues include **Daytona International Speedway, Main Street, Destination Daytona, Beach Street, Midtown, New Smyrna Beach** and **DeLand**. This extended weekend of fun and sun includes motorcycle shows and rallies, live music, scenic rides along A1A and other historic roadways, racing at Daytona International and New Smyrna Speedways and vendors offering everything from the latest cycles to parts and accessories. Arts, Culture & History

The Cici and Hyatt Brown Museum of Art, a 26,000 square foot museum on the campus of the Smithsonian-affiliated Museum of Arts and Sciences, is home to the largest private collection of Florida oil and watercolor paintings in the world. Explore the area's rich history from the top of Ponce Inlet Lighthouse, Florida's tallest, trace the footsteps of educator and civil rights activist Mary McLeod Bethune on a tour of her former home, stop by the Halifax Historical Museum, or take in a game at historic Jackie Robinson Ballpark. See a theatre performance or international symphony concert at Peabody Auditorium, catch an indie movie at Cinematique, or find a new rhythm listening to live music at a variety of area venues.



World's Only Motorsports Stadium



A \$400 million overhaul transformed **Daytona International Speedway** into the world's only motorsports stadium in 2016. This world-class facility, known as the 'World Center of Racing,' features premium amenities and unparalleled conveniences including three concourse levels spanning the frontstretch; five expanded fan entrances called 'injectors'; 11 social areas dubbed 'neighborhoods,' each the size of a football field with open sightlines and dozens of video screens to capture the on-track action; more than 60 luxury trackside suites with patios; 17 elevators and 40 escalators in the grandstand; and, 101,500 new 20"-21" grandstand

seats featuring backs and arm rests. In addition, more than 7,000 solar panels make this sports complex one of the top five largest solar installations at a professional sports venue in the country. In addition to car and motorcycle racing, the stadium is also home to a growing number of events and shows, as well as unique meeting and convention space.

Motorsports Hall of Fame of America



Daytona International Speedway tours include a visit to the not-to-be-missed **Motorsports Hall of Fame of America** and an opportunity to experience spectacular displays honoring all forms of motorsports: Stock Cars, Sports Cars, Open-Wheel, Motorcycles, Drag Racing, Land Speed Records, Powerboating and Aviation. The 10,000 square foot hall, adorned with sculpted images of 230 inductees of the Hall of fame, includes a long list of exclusive vehicles and sights even non-race fans can appreciate.
