4. Wynkoop Brewing Company

Wynkoop is a Denver institution, known for innovative brewers who will put just about anything in their beer, including Rocky Mountain oysters, gummy bears and green chilies. It's known as the brewery that brewed a neighborhood, because Wynkoop helped spur the revitalization of Lower Downtown (LoDo).

6. Tivoli Brewing Company

Tivoli is Colorado's oldest, most historic brewery. It originally opened in 1859 and supplied beer to the gold rush pioneers. Situated in the heart of downtown Denver's Auraria Campus, it's easily accessible via the Platte River and Cherry Creek trails.

7. Renegade Brewing Company

With deep roots in the punk rock music scene, Ratio's co-founders sought to translate the industry's sense of community, DIY spirit and strong musical influences via the beer and taproom experience.

The name combines the Lee family's two passions: beer and sailing. Sailing because the name describes an ocean-going sailboat, and beer because there is great satisfaction in taking a "deep draught" of their house-crafted brews.

12. Epic Brewing

Epic's 25 rotating taps feature go-to favorites along with unique sours and taproom exclusives. Enjoy the bright, spacious taproom and sunny patio in Denver's River North Art District (RiNo). Epic has something for everyone!

13. Prost Brewing Company

Prost combines the best parts of a Bavarian-style biergarten outside with a traditional bier hall layout inside, giving you the feel of an afternoon or evening spent in Munich. The signature copper brewing equipment was shipped from Germany, and the commitment to brewing authentic German-style beer holds true in their Colorado brews.

14. Strange Craft Beer Company

Strange Craft was the first small taproom brewery to open in Denver. With an inviting bar made of reclaimed wood, a spacious outdoor seating area with yard games, rotating food trucks, live music on Saturdays and 12 taps of award-winning beers, there's plenty to enjoy.

15. Crazy Mountain Brewing Company

16. Baere Brewing Co.

Baere hides between a laundromat and nail salon in a strip mall on South Broadway in the eclectic Baker neighborhood. Walking into Baere transforms the feel of the 1970's retail center. The space is filled with barrels from Laws Whiskey House, and there are 15 beers on tap, ranging from Belgian farmhouse styles to hop-forward IPAs to a wide variety of sour offerings on draft and in bottles.

17. The Intrepid Sojourner Beer Project

Inspired by an archaeologist's adventures, Intrepid Sojourner pushes the boundaries of beer's taste with its ever-changing lineup of travel-influenced brews, complemented by non-alcoholic coffee, kombucha and root beer to round out its 20 taps.

ASPIRE TOURS' RINO CRAFT BREWERY TOUR

The River North Art District (RiNo) has transformed from an industrial landscape into one of the hippest spots in Denver. Aspire Tours highlights a few of the RiNo microbreweries that stand out for their unique perspectives on craft beer. aspire-tours.com

MILE HIGH TAP TOURS

Sit back as a 12-passenger van drives you and your friends along South Broadway and Santa Fe Drive on a four-hour tour that covers three breweries. milehightaptours.com

DENVER BREWS CRUISE

On the Denver Brews Cruise, you'll experience the distinct tastes and styles of three of downtown Denver's finest craft breweries. denverbrewscruise.com

DENVER MICROBREW TOUR

A 1.5-mile guided walking tour in Denver's historic Lower Downtown (LoDo) neighborhood, the Denver Microbrew Tour includes 10 samples at four of LoDo's best breweries and taprooms. denvermicrobrewtour.com

BANJO BILLY'S DENVER BREWERY TOUR

Banjo Billy's Denver Brewery Tour includes visits to three local breweries aboard an old school bus redesigned to look like a hill-billy shack, with three pints of beer included. banjobilly.com

DENVER BIKE & BREWS TOUR

This leisurely, four-hour cruise spans five to six miles and takes you to some "hop" spots. atyourpacebiking.com

COORS BREWERY TOUR

Take a free, 30-minute, self-paced tour at the legendary Coors Brewery in nearby Golden — the largest single-site brewery in the world. millercoors.com

Beer Glossary

You've made it to the bar, but it feels like the beer menu was written in another language. Order your next brew with bravado after brushing up on some helpful terminology.

ABV

Alcohol by volume. The higher the ABV, the stronger the beer. The lower end usually starts around 4%, while the stronger stuff can top 10%.

IBU

International bitterness units. The higher the IBU, the more bitter the beer.

IPA

India pale ales might sound exotic but they are highly prevalent in Denver. Simply put, they are very hoppy. There are English-style, American-style, imperial (or double) with extra malt and hops, regional IPAs and even sub-styles within those broader categories. Due to the tremendous variety, the pale ale world is worth lots of taste testing.

ALE

Beers fermented at warmer temps with top-fermenting yeast. Ales often have complex floral or fruit esters (the flavors and aromas produced by yeast during fermentation). You'll find Kölsch beers, noted for their bright yellow or golden hues, in the ale family, too.

CASK-CONDITIONED

These complex, cloudy beers undergo a secondary fermentation in a sealed cask. They're often called "live ales" because they're unfiltered and still contain live yeast when poured. Cask-conditioned beers are best served at "cellar temperature" (about 55°F) and have less carbonation than your typical pint.

LAGER

Beers fermented at cooler temps with bottom-fermenting yeast. Lagers usually have a crisp, clean flavor. Pilsners are pale lagers and are highly popular for their refreshing, fragrant flavors.

SAISON

This highly carbonated, golden-hued Belgian-style beer — a type of farmhouse ale — is dry, earthy, sometimes spicy, maybe even a little funky. The name means "season" in French.

SESSION

Looking for something you can sip all day? Session beers are perfect for ball games and backyard barbecues because of their light body and low alcohol content — generally under 5% ABV.

SOUR

These beers' signature sour taste comes from a mix of benign bacteria and special yeast strains. Brewers call these ingredients "bugs," but don't be put off — you owe it to yourself to give one of these face-puckering pints a try.

STOUT AND PORTER

Both styles are dark, malty (rather than hoppy) beers. Taste ranges from dry and roasty to sweet and creamy, with flavors of coffee, chocolate and caramel. Many new beer drinkers find them intimidating, but with so much variety, there's one for everyone!

WEISSBIER/WIT/WHEAT

As the name implies, these beers trace their lineage to Germany and were unusual when they came about due to their lighter colors. They are typically brewed with a high proportion of malted wheat. American wheat beers are also light in color and may appear cloudy when poured.
