
Whether you are a foodie, a sports enthusiast, a history

Discover Downtown



downtown is centered around the 16th Street Mall, a mile-long pedestrian promenade where free shuttle buses provide easy access to shops, outdoor cafés and attractions.

a show at the Denver Performing Arts Complex; get an

Rockmount; sample Denver's

and historic Union Station; and




head to Denver Pavilions for shopping and entertainment.

Downtown is also home to Civic Center Park, the Colorado State Capitol and History Colorado Center. And, the B-cycle bike-sharing program provides a great way to experience Denver's unique neighborhoods.

Explore LoDo



oDo (Lower Downtown) is Denver's trendy, historic district where turn-of-the-century red brick buildings have been transformed into brew pubs, sports bars, restaurants and clubs. Denver Union Station is the city's newest hotspot and transportation hub, featuring a boutique hotel, Terminal Bar, restaurants, shops and the elegant Cooper Lounge.



Rail service connects Denver International Airport to this downtown landmark. The adjacent Riverfront area offers beautiful parks and paths, as



well as shops and restaurants, all along the South Platte River. It's a short walk or bike ride to Elitch Gardens Theme & Water Park, the Downtown Aquarium, Pepsi Center, Sports Authority Field at Mile High and Children's Museum of Denver at Marsico Campus.

enver's creative side is thriving with one-of-a-kind museums like the Clyfford Still Museum and the Kirkland Museum of Fine & Decorative Art; neighborhood art districts filled with galleries and studios; and



public art and contemporary murals around every corner. The Denver Art Museum is famous for its American Indian and Western art collections, and the Museum of Contemporary Art offers ever-changing exhibits.



The Denver Performing Arts Complex offers 10 venues for theater, opera, symphony, dance and Broadway shows. The Mile High City's live music scene is also booming with local bands and unique venues, from the legendary Red Rocks Park & Amphitheatre to intimate jazz clubs and vintage theaters.

enver has six sports stadiums and a record seven professional teams, including the NFL Denver Broncos, NHL Colorado Avalanche, NBA Denver Nuggets, MLB Colorado Rockies, MLS Colorado Rapids, NLL Colorado Mammoth and MLL Denver Outlaws. Denver also has one of the



world's largest rodeos and the biggest professional soccer stadium and field complex in the world,



Dick's Sporting Goods Park, with an 18,000-seat stadium surrounded by 23 soccer fields. There are 90 golf courses and 85 miles of paved, off-street biking, hiking and jogging trails.

ust an hour from some of the world's most beautiful scenery, Denver makes an excellent base to tour the scenic and historic nearby Rocky Mountains.




Enjoy Colorado's ski country at dozens of resorts offering year-round recreation – skiing, golf, horseback riding and more.

Denver Neighborhoods



enver boasts a number of hidden gem neighborhoods. Five
Points is the center of the African American community and the location of three museums about the history of Blacks in the West. The Art District on Santa Fe, including the Museo de las Americas,



RiNo (River North) Art District and Tennyson Street Cultural District are home to dozens of galleries, shops and unique restaurants. Highlands is a



hip neighborhood with chic outdoor cafés, brewpubs and galleries, while South Broadway features Antique Row, restaurants, clubs and bars. Music lovers flock to East Colfax's many live music venues, and Capitol Hill offers a glimpse of Denver's past with historic mansions, churches and museums. Old South Gaylord and South Pearl Street offer two enclaves of trendy restaurants and shops near beautiful Washington Park.


American dance competition in the country.

Denver International Airport



enver International Airport is the sixth busiest airport in North America and the 19th busiest in the world, offering 1,550 daily nonstops to nearly 180 worldwide destinations. The airport features local independent restaurants and shops, as well as innovative art installations.





The Westin Denver International Airport is adjacent to the main terminal, and direct rail service connects Denver International Airport to downtown Denver's Union Station for \$9 each way.




