#### **Ossagon Trail**

Ancient redwoods, Sitka spruce and ocean views are all a part of this ride. Begin at the Elk Prairie Visitor Center for this 19 mile loop out to the coast and back.

# 8 Lost Man Creek Trail

A scenic, 11 mile hike and bike trail takes you through redwood forest. Combine with Bald Hills Rd. and Hwy 101 for a 20 mile loop.

#### Humboldt Redwoods MUT

Over 75 miles of Multi-Use Trail are open to mountain bikes, including Look Prairie Trail, Pole Line Rd, Fox Camp Trail, Kemp Trail & Perimeter Rd.

# 0 Paradise Royale

The crown jewel of Humboldt County singletrack, 23 miles of scenic vistas, backcountry settings, and developed bike park features.

### **MORE FAMILY RIDES**

# 11 Hikshari' Trail

Level, paved trail from Elk River Access to Truesdale Ave. offering birdwatching and bay views; soon to connect with the 6.5 mile Eureka Waterfront Trail.

### Arcata Bottoms

A dozen square miles of farms and pastures to explore on country roads. Access from Samoa Blvd. to Jackson Ranch Rd., Giuntoli to Heindon Rd. & points between.

# Ferndale Farmlands

The Eel River Valley around the Victorian Village of Ferndale is crisscrossed by country lanes through farms and fields. Cross the river at Fernbridge and explore.




