This mid-September weekend tradition empties the garages and attics of all Ferndale, which offers a golden opportunity to find inexpensive antiques and more. **707-786-4477**


14 North Country Fair



SHOPPING DISTRICTS

1 Old Town Eureka

The Victorian seaport features more than 19th century architecture, but a lively commercial district with eclectic bookstores, antique shops, art galleries, souvenir shops, chic apparel and storefronts that specialize in Humboldtmade foods and goods.

2 Downtown Fortuna

The Friendly City boasts fine antique stores on Main Street like the Antique Depot, which with about 20 vendors is largest antique mall in the county. Gas pumps, Amish bowls, vintage toys and more abound. For a science detour, go south a few miles to Chapman's Gem & Mineral Shop.

3 Progressive Arcata

Known as Sixties By the Sea, Arcata's downtown merits a mention among the hippy capitals of California. with tie-dye stores, left-wing political bookstores, bead and crystal shops, and other counter-culture staples. Don't miss the historic Jacoby Storehouse.

4 Historic Ferndale

Known as California's best
preserved Victorian Village,
Ferndale's Main Street and
its storefronts seem frozen in
time. Nineteenth century curios,
antiques, the old drug store, a
mercantile emporium, a black
smith shop and more await
those seeking historic treasures.

Local woodsmen transform fallen trees into beautiful pieces of art and furniture, including slabs of burl into tables, Bigfoots, and whatnot. Look for their works on Hwy 101 in the far north around Orick and the far south near Garberville.


