


Introduction

- All data was collected by the Epicenter Church staff/volunteers during the event.
- Epicenter management estimated **25,000** attendees prior to the event.
- There were 114 completed surveys.
- Using the 25,000 attendees, the Confidence Interval for this presentation with a 114 Sample Size is +/- 9.16%. Because of the size of the sample the Confidence Interval did not meet the "best practice" of +/- 5%.

Overview


- All **114** completed surveys provided a valid zip code.

Not all Tourism Development Authority (TDA) requirements were met:
 378 completed surveys was the agreed upon requirement (only 114 collected)
 Surveys Completed Each Hour of the Event

- Room Nights Because the required sample size was below the TDA required amount, the FACVB was unable to accurately project room nights.
- **0%** of participants were overnighters and came specifically for the event.
- 0 participants were referred by hotels.
- 75.44% were from Cumberland County, including Fort Bragg.
- 14.91% were day-trippers.
- Participants heard of the event mainly by Facebook (31%) and Word of Mouth (22%)
- 68 attendees signed up for the FACVB's E-Promotion Program and provided a valid E-mail address.
