Welcome: Angie Brady, FACVB, opened the meeting at 3:03pm by welcoming the group and thanking all for attending today's meeting. Angie decided to start the meeting with group introductions then quickly gave an update from the CVB:

- She updated the group on the new Visitor Guide and explained the merging of the guide with the Cultural Heritage Trail Guide. The new guides should be out in September.
- o Each department has been working on and finishing the budget for upcoming fiscal year.
- The CVB is embarking on a new website. The new website will be very different from the current one; it will be more image driven and user friendly. There is currently no date of completion.
- Heroes Homecoming V is heavy in the planning stages and coming in November. The Veterans Day Parade on November 4th, 2017 will be the kick-off event and the remainder of the following week will have different events going on leading up to Veterans Day, November 11th.

Visitor Profile/Social Media/PR Report: Angie then turned to the meeting over to David Nash to discuss Visitor Profile, Social Media and PR Report. He briefly went over the slides for each that were in the hand outs, and also explained how the information was collected.
