Introduction

- All data was collected and provided by the gallery staff.
- There were an estimated **2,500** attendees.
- There were **2,400** completed surveys.
- Using the estimated number of attendees (2,500), the Confidence Interval for this presentation with a 2,400 Sample Size is +/- 0.4%. Because of the size of the sample the Confidence Interval FAR EXCEEDS the "best practice" of +/- 5%.

Overview

- 10 completed surveys had invalid zip code information.
- 93% were from North Carolina, and 89% were from within 100 miles of Fayetteville.
- 72% identified themselves as being from Fayetteville, Cumberland County, or stationed at Fort Bragg.

Bottom Line

- The sample size was **phenomenal** and **far exceeded** the "best practices" for sample versus attendees.
- 2,500 attendees
- 0.71% of attendees (17 attendees) were overnighters and came specifically for the event extrapolated out to 2,500 attendees this means potentially 18 people X 1 overnight* = 18 room nights (+/- 0.4%)

* of those that were overnighters, not enough answered the question on how long they stayed, therefore we were unable to determine if they averaged longer than a single night.

- Of those that stayed in a hotel, one provided the name of the hotel: Fairfield Inn, Marriott.
- 2 attendees who were here for other reasons were referred by the hotel they were staying at.
- **72%** were from Cumberland County including Fort Bragg.
- 14% were day trippers.
- Attendees heard of event from Word of Mouth (33%), Invitation (24%) and Fayetteville Observer (10%).
