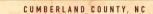


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Introduction

 All data was collected by the Communities in Schools staff during the event using electronic survey on IPAD or on paper and manually entered after the event.

Note: At the end of the day on the 19th (day after event) there were 105 completed surveys electronically submitted. The FACVB was notified on Monday, November 20th that there were over 300 completed paper surveys still to be entered. The final number of completed surveys should be over 400, there are approximately 60 missing completed surveys.

- Communities in Schools management estimated 3,000 attendees prior to the event.
- There were 344 completed surveys.
- Using the 3,000 attendees, the Confidence Interval for this presentation with a 344
 Sample Size is +/- 4.97%. Because of the size of the sample the Confidence
 Interval was slightly better than the "best practice" of +/- 5%.

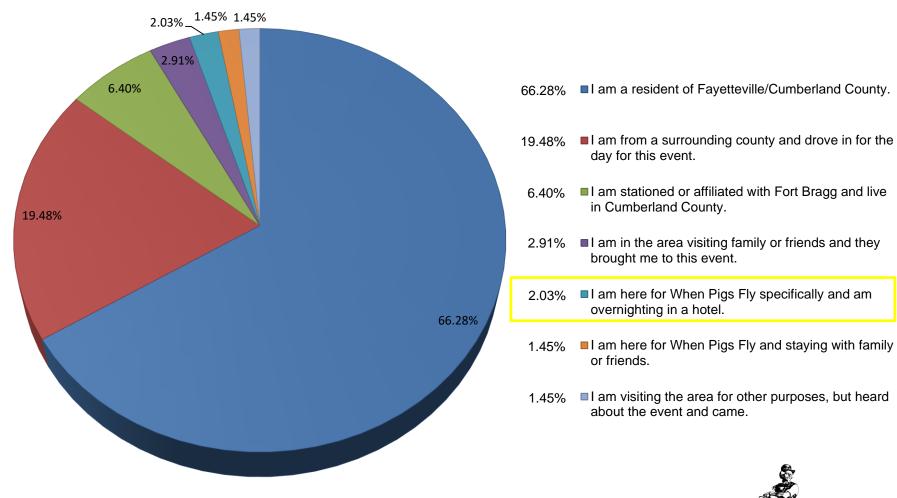
 Communities in Schools staff wanted to know of those that lived in Cumberland County, how many had school aged children:

Overview

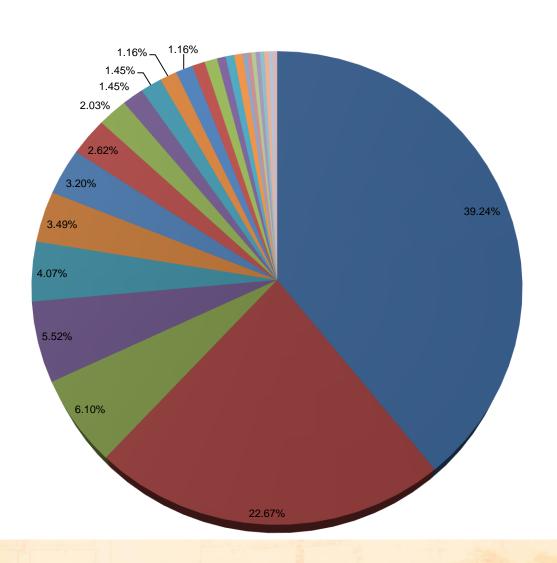
- 2 of the 344 completed surveys provided an invalid zip code.

Bottom Line

- All Tourism Development Authority (TDA) requirements were met, however the number of surveys
 collected just met the minimum and there may be more surveys that were not entered.
- 341 completed surveys was the agreed upon requirement (344 collected)
- 2.03% (7) of the completed surveys were overnighters and came specifically for the event. However 5 of the 7 then stated they did not stay at a hotel.
- **0** participants were referred by their hotel.
- 72.67% were from Cumberland County, including Fort Bragg.
- 19.48% were day-trippers.
- Participants heard of the event mainly by Word of Mouth (39.24%) and a Facebook (22.67%).
- **96** attendees signed up for the FACVB's E-Promotion Program and **93** provided a valid E-mail address.





Bottom Line Continue

- For the calculations, the FACVB used the agreed upon estimated attendance number provided by the Communities in Schools management of **3,000**. The sample size of **344** was slightly more than the required and agreed upon **341** completed surveys necessary to ensure the presentation met "best practices" of +/- 5%, as a result this presentation is at +/- 4.97%.
- Of those participants staying at a hotel, the overall average length of stay was 1 night.
- 2.03% of the participants (7) were overnighters and came specifically for the event extrapolated out to 3,000 participants this means <u>potentially</u> 61 people X 1 nights = 61 room nights (+/- 4.97%) Once again this may not be accurate as 5 of the 7 stated after selecting they were here for the event that they did NOT stay in a hotel.
- The 7 who came for the event and stayed at a hotel, listed the following hotels:
 - 5 = "None", 1 = No Answer, 1 = Ambassador Inn
- Official Hotel Pick Up: 0 Room Nights as reported from hotels.
