# HIKES, WALKS & WATERFALLS

## Hiking with Waterfalls

### **Barnes Creek Gully, Onanda Park, Canandaigua.**

1.1-mile loop trail, moderate elevation. 3 waterfalls: 35 ft.; 8 ft. and 50 ft. high. Best time to visit is in the spring with the best water flow.

### **Grimes Glen County Park, Naples.**

## Walking and Hiking along the Water

**Canadice Lake Walking Path** is a 7.3 mile out and back trail, along the western shoreline. Connects to Rob's Trail connecting the protected lakes of Hemlock and Canadice. Both known for birding, nature walks, moderate. Access via Old Bald Hill Rd., Springwater.

**Flint Creek Loop Trail, Ontario Pathways, Phelps.** This section of the abandoned railbed runs along Flint Creek, with access to the Double Drop Falls. Leashed dogs are welcome! [ontariopathways.org](http://ontariopathways.org).

**Kershaw Park, Canandaigua and the Canandaigua City Pier.** A walking path from the New York Wine & Culinary Center to Twisted Rail and across to Lagoon Park.

**Manchester Gateway Trail, Manchester.** Handicapped accessible, guided exercise options, and places to relax along the Canandaigua Outlet.

**Naples Creek Trail, Rt. 21 Naples.** Connects to Naples Community Park and the Finger Lakes Trail and heads up to High Tor wildlife area.

**Seneca Lake State Park and Geneva Lakefront Park.** Start at the Geneva Visitors Center and stroll along the lakefront or through the underpass to Downtown Geneva.

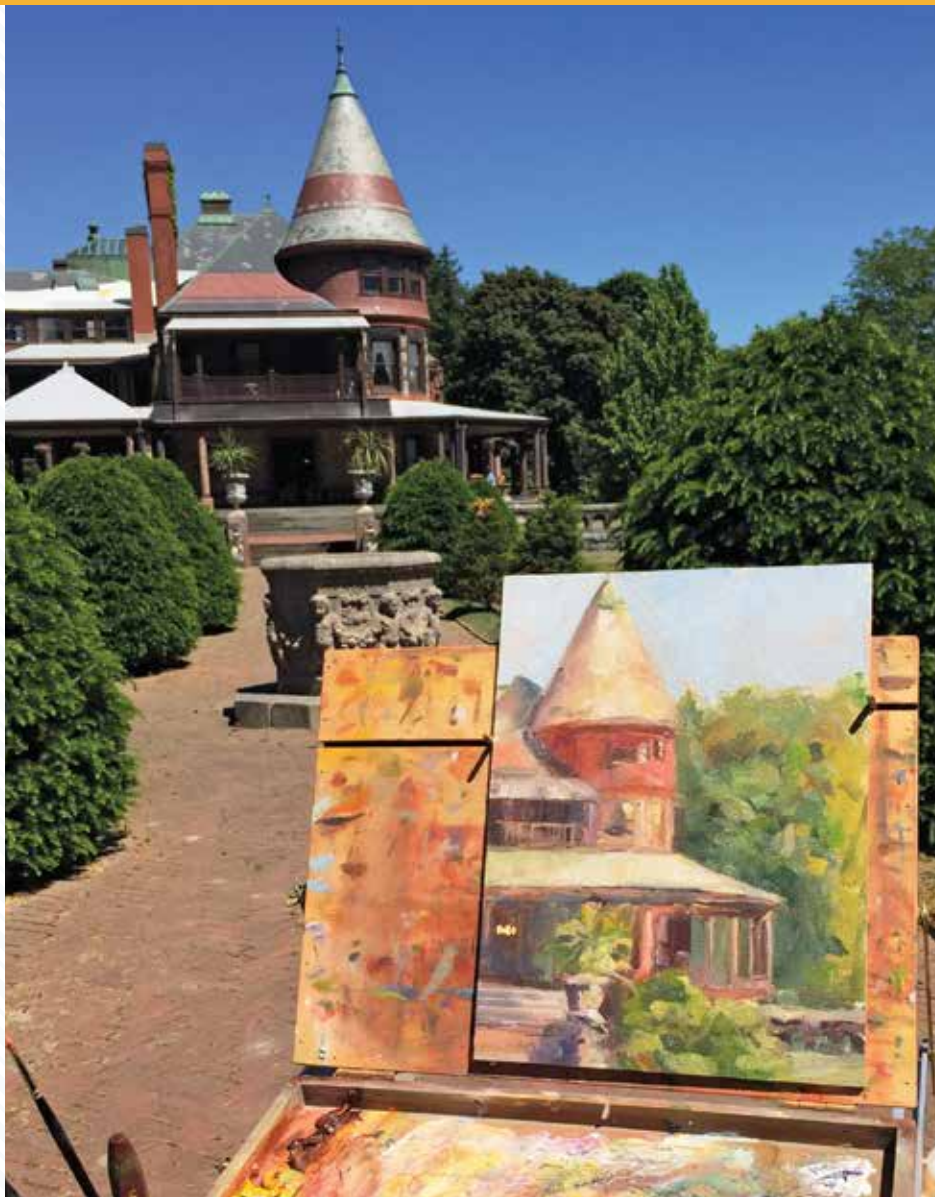

The site of Genesee Yearly Meeting of Friends was a national crucible for major reform movements in the nineteenth century. It stood at the crossroads of activism for African American rights, women's rights, and Native American rights. As a part of the National Park Services' Underground Railroad Network to Freedom, the museum has a stamp for National Park Service passports.

## 2 Antique Wireless Association Museum

Dedicated to preserving and sharing the history of technology used to communicate from the first telegraph to today's wireless text messaging. Nearly 200 years of communication technology history and a world-class collection of communications artifacts, includes the control room and 250,000 watt transmitter from the Voice of America Station in Delano, California, a Western Union Telegraph office, an exact replica of the Titanic's wireless room. See the world's first experimental FM transmitter, first transistor radio, and first operating cellphone (Serial Number 0001).

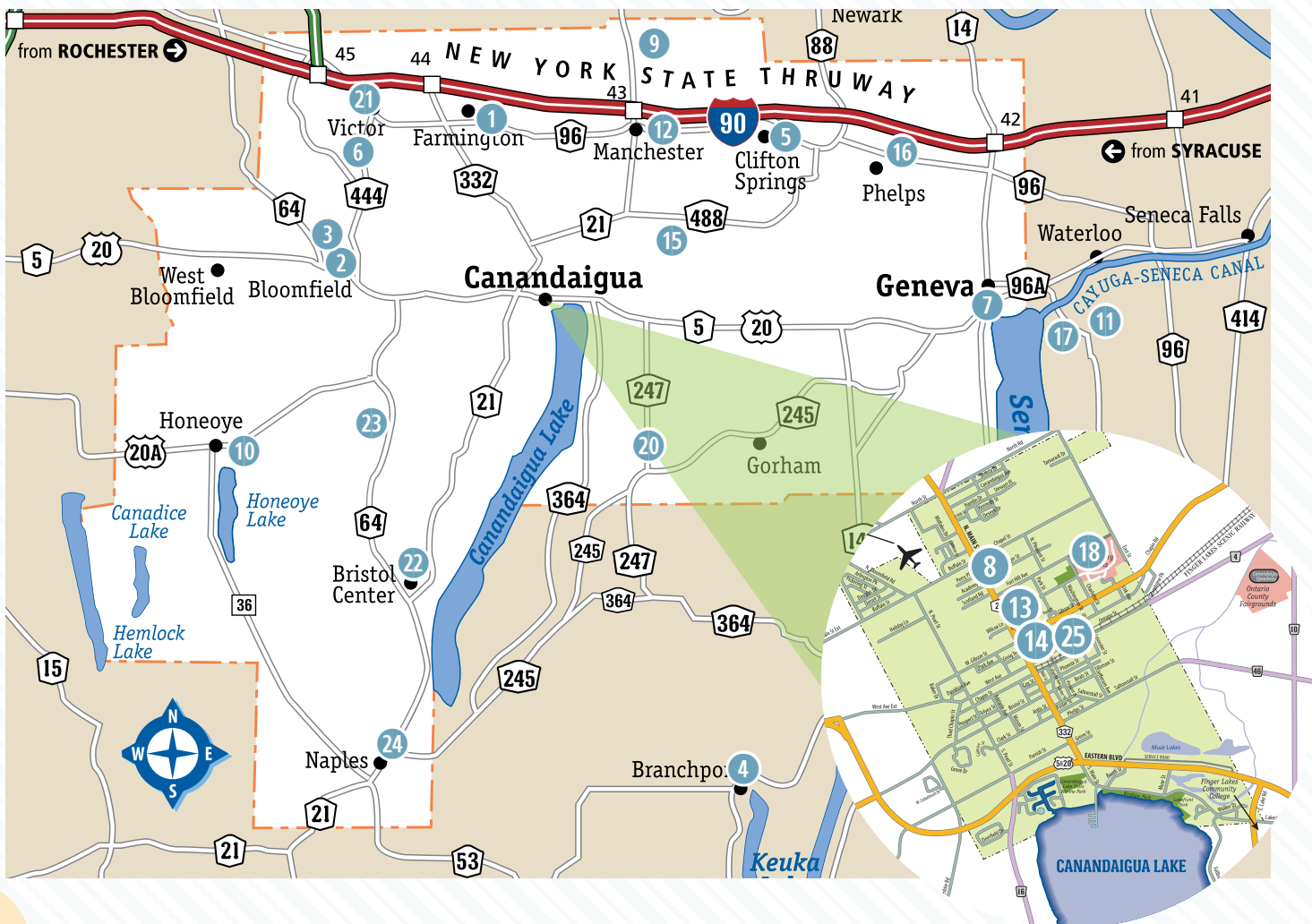

Displays show Dr. Foster's life, the local nursing school (1894-1934) and other local businesses, including those who served in our Armed Forces. A pictorial time line shows the changes of the village from 1850 to 2000 when the Clifton Springs Hospital celebrated its 150th anniversary.

## 6 Ganondagan State Historic Site & the Seneca Art and Culture Center

Ganondagan stands at the location of what was once a vital 17th-century Seneca town. Explore five centuries of art, culture, and history through interactive and multi-media exhibits at the **Seneca Art & Culture Center**, find one-of-a-kind artisan items at the Gift Shop, tour a full-sized replica of a 17th-century bark longhouse, and enjoy self-guided tours through marked trails on the Site's 500+ acres. The site, its interpreters and its Friends group are resources on Haudenosaunee (Iroquois) Confederacy and its message of peace. Events include the Native American Winter Games in February, Native American Dance & Music Festival in July, Living History event in September, and the annual Canandaigua Treaty Day in November. The Friends of Ganondagan also oversees the Iroquois White Corn Project that grows, processes, and sells the traditional heirloom corn, and creates programs for nutrition, community, and education.

## 7 Geneva History Museum at Prouty-Chew House

Displays include three rooms furnished in late 19th-century style, a children's discovery room, and the permanent exhibit Geneva's Changing Landscapes. Two galleries provide various changing exhibitions over the course of the year. The Society sells a selection of local history books and architectural walking tours at the museum.

## 8 Granger Homestead & Carriage Museum

1816 Federal mansion and Carriage Museum features a remarkable collection of over 100 horse-drawn carriages and farm implements for display. Built for Gideon Granger, Postmaster General for Presidents Jefferson and Madison. 19th century law office, museum gift shop and special events throughout the year such as Derby Day in May, Arts in the Gardens in August, the Festival of Trees and Christkindl Market in November.

## 9 Hill Cumorah & Visitors Center

Learn about the history of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints in the Finger Lakes. Interactive audio and video displays, as well as free, guided tours. Each July, the Hill Cumorah Pageant takes place here telling the story of how church founder Joseph Smith received the tablets from Moroni that were later transcribed into the Book of Mormon.

## 10 The Honeoye-Richmond Historical Society Museum

The Ontario County Courthouse is the infamous location of Susan B. Anthony's treason trial, after she voted in the 1917 election. The courthouse is still a fully-functioning courthouse and has limited access due to the trial schedule, but an outside view, especially of the golden Lady Justice is one of the favorite picture spots in Ontario County. Additionally, this is the site of the November 11, Pickering (Canandaigua) Treaty Celebration at the courthouse rock.

See twenty rooms restored and furnished in the Empire style, popular from the 1820s to 1850s. Through family letters, photographs, and diaries explore the family's joys, sorrows and interactions with the community. The Gift Shop features locally produced food products, historically-themed gifts and handcrafted items.

## 18 Sonnenberg Gardens & Mansion State Historic Park

This has become a popular site for Finger Lakes Plein Air artists and weddings. Some of Sonnenberg's special events include the Father's Day Car Show (June), Moonlight Stroll Music Series (July & August), and Arts at the Gardens Fine Art & Fine Craft Show & Sale (August) featuring 100 top-quality artists from across the country. Educational gardening and horticulture classes are available. **The Finger Lakes Wine Center**, featuring more than 40 partner wineries, is here.

We have adapted to the modern world, but we still maintain our language, ceremonies, land base, government, lineages and culture. When you're a native person, your story is often told by other people. Here, we tell our own story." - G. Peter Jemison (Heron Clan, Seneca) Historic Site Manager.

In 1940 it was converted into a museum and contains much of the original setup including a general store, meeting room, bakery, harness shop, cobbler's shop, music school, railroad telegraph office, ticket office, and a ballroom.

## Additional Historical Resource agencies

**22 The South Bristol Historical Society** is located in the historic Grange Hall on Rt. 64 in South Bristol (Naples). Built in 1923, it has a large working kitchen, dining room, and second floor dance hall which houses local historic artifacts. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Watch for special events.

## 23 The Town of Bristol Historical Society

The United Church serves as the home for the historical society. It is located at the corner of Baptist Hill Road and Oakmount. There is also a rotating display in the Bristol Town Hall just off Rt. 64, (Canandaigua). Bristol is home to the Burning Springs. The town works closely with other historical agencies to tie the history of Western New York together.

## 24 The Naples Historical Society

Naples was originally called Watkinstown, then Middletown, and in 1808 it became Naples, reminiscent of the grape culture of Italy. The active historical society holds several events at its various facilities in town and promotes a guide for a landmark tour of homes in Naples.

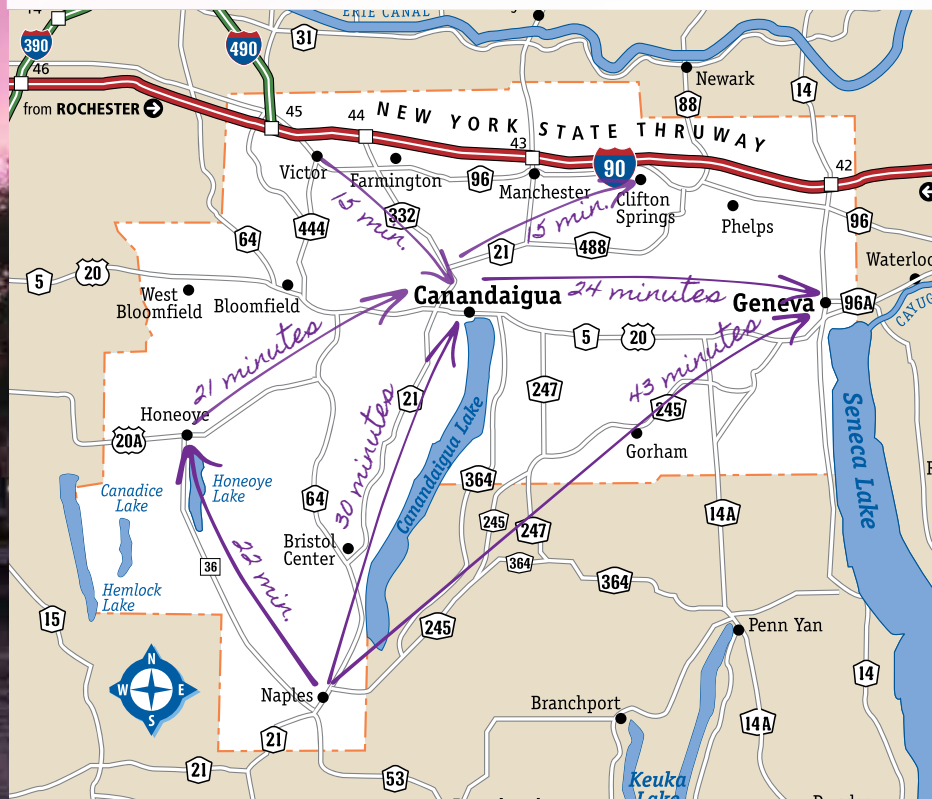
