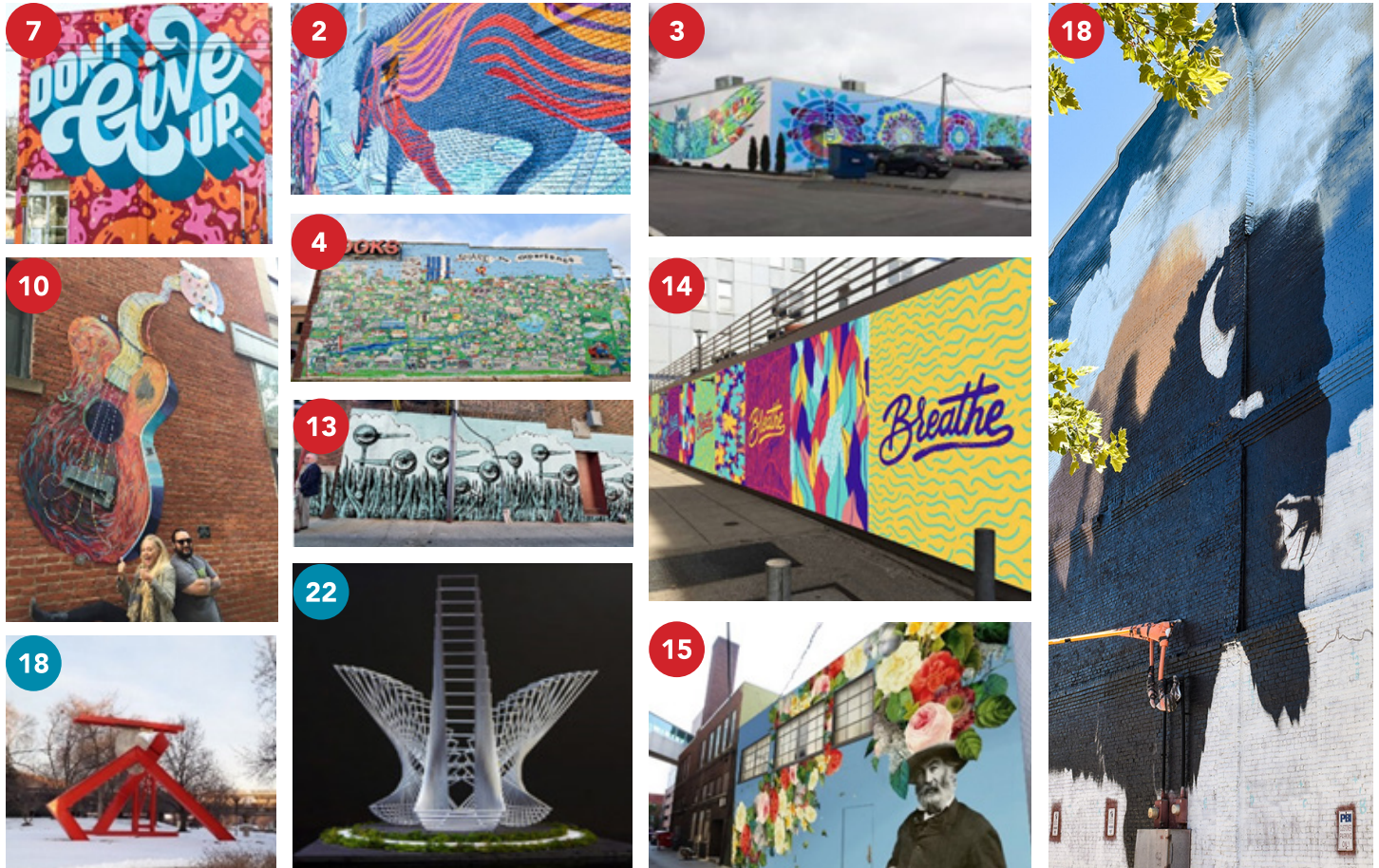


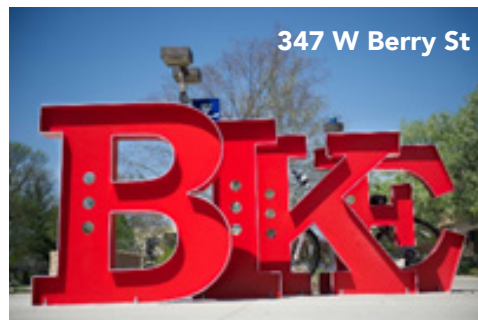
Fort Wayne Public Art

Sculpture With Purpose - Bike Rack Sculptures

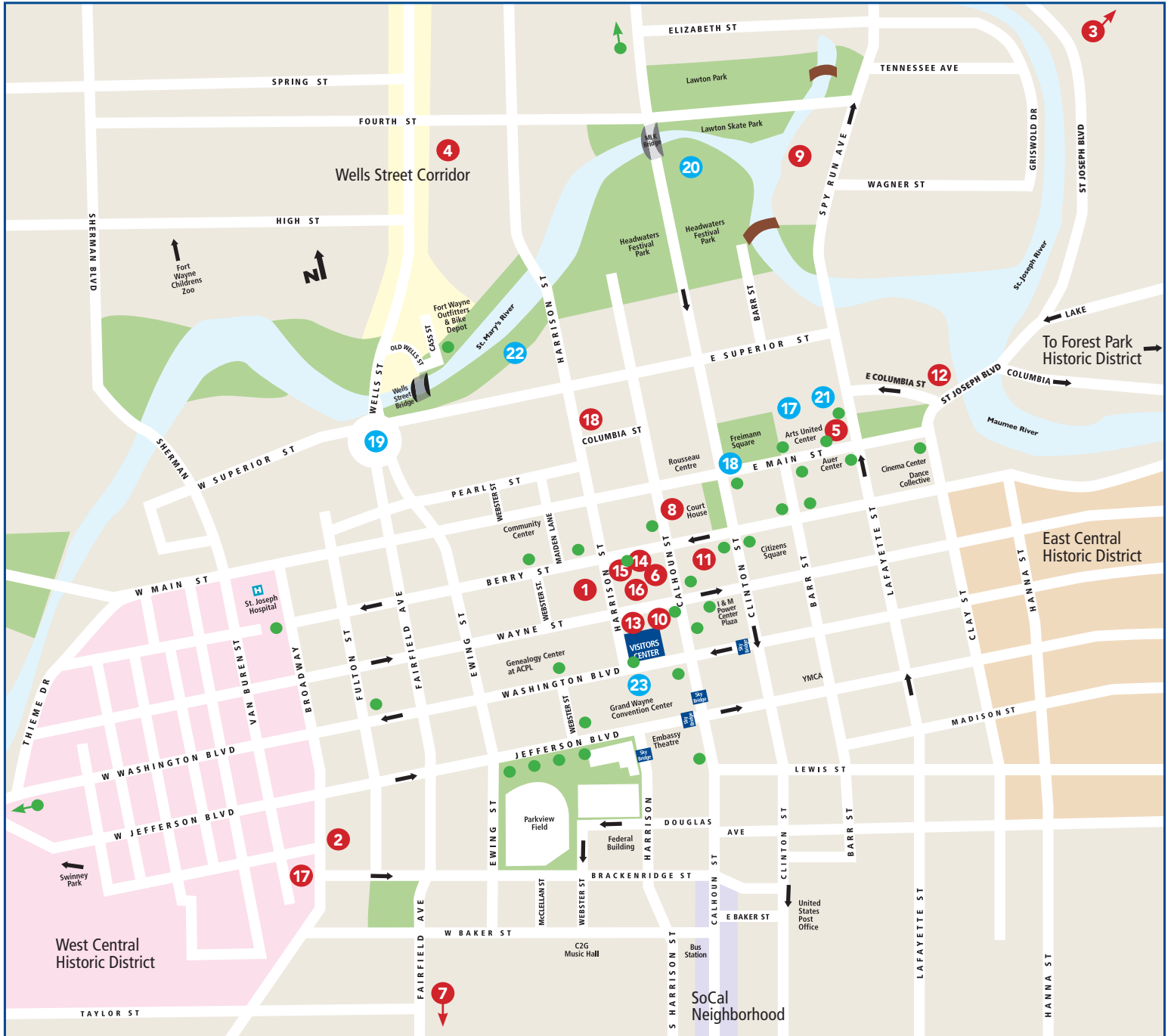
