Play on the Rivers

If you're ready to venture onto the waters, you can do it by canoe, single or double kayak, or standing paddleboard. <u>Fort Wayne Outfitters</u> rents all three at hourly, half-day, and full-day rates. River Cruises

Experience the city by taking a boat ride on one of the three rivers in Downtown Fort Wayne. You can enjoy rides along the river this summer with:

<u>Canal Boat</u> – NEW - Travel Fort Wayne Rivers on Sweet Breeze, Fort Wayne's authentic 1840s canal boat replica. This is not a boat ride, it's an experience! Both 90 and 45 minute tours are available to entertain riders with colorful river lore stories, Fort Wayne history from the riverbank and muddy water tales. You'll leave your voyage knowing more about our city, our heritage, and our water supply. Fort Wayne is home to 86<u>parks</u> and more than 90 miles of trails, the most prominent of which is Rivergreenway. The Rivergreenway Trail stretches 25 miles from Fort Wayne to New Haven, winding along the banks of the rivers. This trail is perfect for walking, jogging, rollerblading, biking, and more.
