SNAPSHOT FROM THE UK OFFICE

The UK sales and marketing team attended a Florida training day organized by leading Scottish tour operator, Barhavel Travel at their luxury travel store in Glasgow. The team also attended the Visit Florida Tour Operator Luncheon at Balthazar in Central London. The event provided the opportunity to network with 15 key tour operators and airlines from across the UK in an informal setting while discussing the latest issues and trends relating to UK travel to Florida during the business advisory session.

FLYING HIGH

Total passenger traffic for March 2015 was 2,658,793, up 7.6% over March last year. Domestic traffic increased by 5.4% and international traffic was up 18.5%. March 2015 was the busiest month in total passenger traffic on record and is the 16th consecutive month of double-digit growth in international passenger traffic. Airport's Council International (ACI) data for the 12 months ending March 2015 ranked FLL 2nd among large hub airports in total passenger growth. Air Carrier Operations were 23,420, up 8.1% over March last year (average of 33 operations a day). General Aviation was 4,067, up 15.3% over last year. Total aircraft operations were 27,487, up 9.1% over March 2014. New service includes: JetBlue to Mexico City in October, Baltimore and Philadelphia in November, Albany in December. JetBlue has also announced new service to Quito, Ecuador beginning in the first quarter of 2016. Southwest will begin new service to Washington National in August with two daily flights. Allegiant began new service to Memphis and Concord, NC in May and has plans to add additional service in the next few months.

RAPA NUI REEF

The Rapa Nui Reef in Deerfield Beach, a combination of a man-made reef with the splendor of public art, will be an underwater sculptural environment for divers to explore and marine life to inhabit. Rapa Nui is the Polynesian translation of Easter Island, and the reef serves as a tribute to the iconic stone figures found on the island. The 14 "Moai" figures range from 6 to 22 feet tall and are placed on concrete structures designed to facilitate the growth of marine life, and will be sunk on June 7 into 70 feet of water between the second and third reef directly off of the Deerfield Beach International Fishing Pier.
