### 20 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS OF TOURISM GROWTH

July 2011 had the highest hotel occupancy since 2006, up 7.8% from 2010. Overall, year-to-date hotel occupancy is 74.4%, up 6.1% year-over-year. July 2011 saw the highest average daily rate since 2008 and has been "in the black" for the past five months. Tourist tax collections show double-digit growth over the last four months with an increase of 8.17% in July 2011 and 12.2% in June 2011. July 2011 marked the 23rd month of consecutive growth in total passenger traffic and was the busiest July on record. Total traffic for the month was 2,037,607, up 4.4% over July last year. International traffic was 339,332, up 1.3% over last year. American Airlines has announced service to Los Angeles in November and additional Chicago and Dallas service in February; Vision will begin service to Freeport in November; and Southwest will begin service to Milwaukee and Manchester (MA) in February.
