HORTON HOUSE
Major William Horton was granted Jekyll Island by the Trustees of the colony of Georgia in 1738, and he constructed this home in 1743. It is one of the oldest standing tabby structure exteriors in the state and is open to the public daily. (N. Riverview Drive, jekyllisland.com)



DRIFTWOOD BEACH
Located on the north end of Jekyll Island, Driftwood beach will amaze you with the beautiful driftwood and trees that resemble a tree graveyard. It also offers a wonderful location for photographs and is a very popular site for weddings.



JEKYLL ISLAND HISTORIC DISTRICT
For one of the largest ongoing restoration projects in the southeastern U.S., work to preserve the site has resulted in Jekyll Island named to the National Trust for Historic Preservation's 12 Distinctive Destinations and receiving the 2008 Georgia Trust for Historic Preservation's Marguerite William Award for Preservation.
