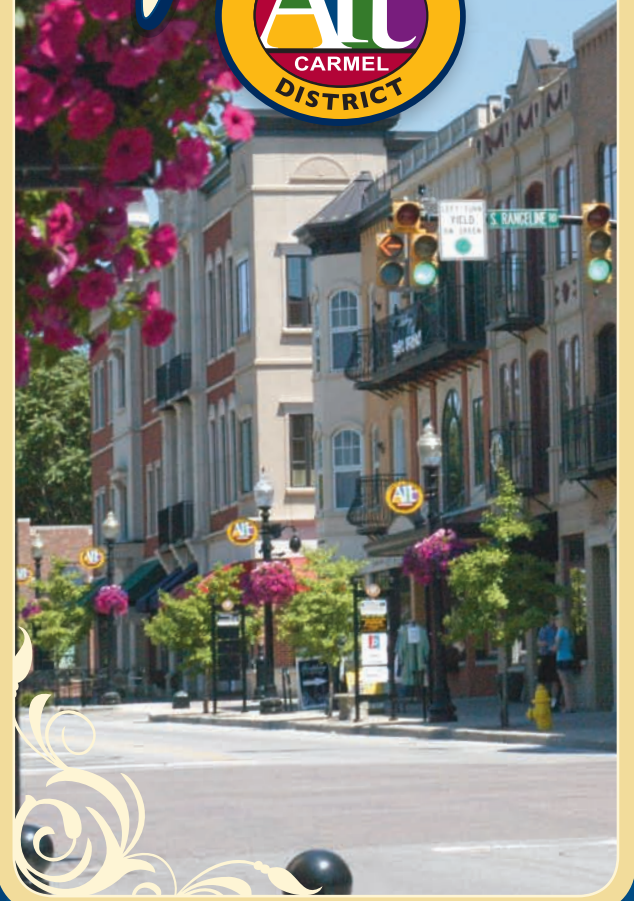

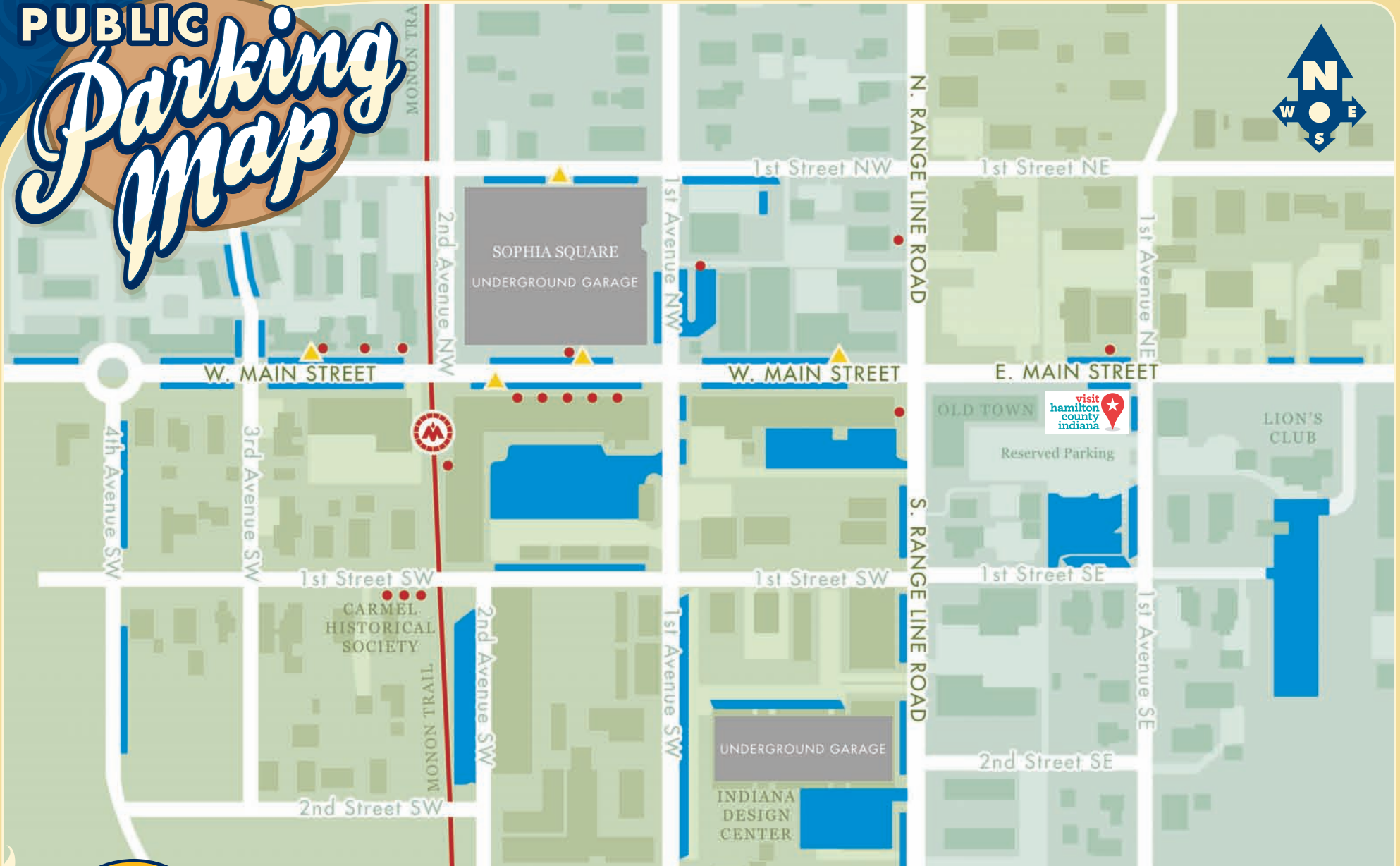
PUBLIC Parking Map
