Visitors, be sure to include these premier trails in your plans. Well-marked, paved trails will lead you to shopping, dining, sightseeing and family fun.

Find the perfect trail

With over 300 miles of trails in Hamilton County there are many levels of trails and loops. This list will help you find the trail most suited for you.

Loop Difficulty Level

FAMILY/BEGINNER – Suitable for children. Flat, easy rides on dedicated trail or neighborhood roads.

ADVANCED – Obstacles may include difficult road crossings, hills, and a lack of shoulder or sidewalk along road.

EXPERT – Should only be attempted by expert cyclists. Obstacles may include difficult road crossings, riding on 45-50 mph roads, a lack of shoulder or sidewalk along road, and hilly terrain.

CARMEL

- **City Center Loop – 6.8 miles** (family/beginner) – grid C4
Points of interest: City Center, City Hall, Old Town and Arts & Design District, Central Park, Monon Center, Monon Trail, Hotel Corridor, Meadowlark Park and Old Meridian
- **Cool Creek Loop – 13.9 miles** (advanced) – grid D5
Points of interest: Carey Grove Park, Mohawk Trails Elementary, 116th Street bike lanes, Flowing Well Park, Clay Junior High and Cherry Tree Trail
- **Hagan-Burke Trail – 1.4 miles** (family/beginner) – grid D4
Connects the Monon Trail in Carmel to the 146th Street Trail. Cross 146th Street to connect to Westfield's Cool Creek Trail.
- **Village Loop – 12.5 miles** (advanced) – C4
Points of interest: Coxhall Gardens, The Village of West Clay, Our Lady of Mount Carmel and Monon Trail
- **West Loop – 9.7 miles** (family/beginner) – grid A5
Points of interest: College Wood Elementary, Creekside Middle School, West Clay Elementary, Carmel Dads Club Football and Lacrosse Field and Westfield
- **White River Loop – 7.2 miles** (family/beginner) – grid E4
Points of interest: White River Greenway, Prairie Meadow Park, Inlow Park, Hazel Dell Parkway Trail, River Heritage Park, River Road Park and White River Wildflower Area

FISHERS

- **Cheeny Creek Loop – 3.5 miles** (family/beginner) – grid F5
Points of interest: Cheeny Creek Natural Area, Nickel Plate District
- **Heritage Park Loop – 8.1 miles** (advanced) – grid E6
Points of interest: Heritage Park, White River, The Historic Ambassador House, Nickel Plate District
- **Holland Park Loop – 2.3 miles** (family/beginner) – grid F5
Points of interest: Roy G. Holland Memorial Park, Nickel Plate District
- **Ritchey Woods Loop – 5.5 miles** (advanced) – grid F5
Points of interest: Ritchey Woods Nature Preserve, Nickel Plate District
- **Saxony Beach Loop – 8.2 miles** (advanced) – grid I5
Note: The pedestrian crossing light, just south of HSE high school, is the best way to cross Ohio Road.
Points of interest: Bee Camp Creek Trailhead, Saxony Beach, Hamilton Southeastern High School, Fall Creek Intermediate School

NOBLESVILLE

- **Deer Creek Loop – 10.5 miles** (family/beginner) – grid G3
Points of interest: Promise Road Elementary, Klipsch Music Center, Hamilton Town Center, Stonycreek Golf Club, Sagamore Golf Club
- **Dillon Park Loop – 8.2 miles** (family/beginner) – grid E3
Points of interest: Hazel Dell Elementary, Noble Crossing Elementary, Dillon Park, Midland Trace
- **Morse Reservoir Loop – 9.3 miles** (family/beginner) – grid E1
Points of interest: Morse Beach Park, Hague Road Park, Hinkle Creek Elementary
- **White River Loop – 12.6 miles** (advanced) – grid H2
Points of interest: White River Canoe Launch, Potter's Bridge Park

WESTFIELD

- **All Roads Loop – 5 miles** (advanced) – grid D2
Points of interest: Heartland Growers display garden, Freedom Trail Park, Asa Bales Park, Fallen Hoosier Heroes Memorial and Westfield High School
 - **Asa-Freedom Loop – 3.5 miles** (family/beginner) – grid D2
Points of interest: Asa Bales Park, Freedom Trail Park and downtown Westfield
 - **Cool Creek Trail – .9 miles** (family/beginner) – grid D3
Connects the internal trails of Cool Creek Park to Carmel's Hagan-Burke Trail.
 - **Little Eagle Creek Loop – 14.7 miles** (expert) – grid A3
This loop is hilly and entirely on paved roads with little to no shoulder, but it is a very pleasant ride with many curves, mature trees, and the Little Eagle Creek.
Points of interest: Little Eagle Creek
 - **Midland-Cool Creek Loop – 7.8 miles** (family/beginner) – grid D3
Points of interest: Cool Creek Park
 - **Midland Trace Trail – 2.3 miles** (family/beginner) – grid D3
Segments of this trail are still in planning and development. It will follow the abandoned Central Indiana Railway corridor to connect Westfield and Noblesville.
 - **Monon-Midland Inner Loop – 7.4 miles** (advanced) – grid C2
Points of interest: Quaker Park, Cool Creek Park and Asa Bales Park
 - **Monon-Midland Outer Loop – 7.5 miles** (family/beginner) – grid C3
This loop travels mostly through subdivisions and paved trails, and is perfect for the whole family. Points of interest: Quaker Park and the Monon Trail
 - **Natalie Wheeler Trail – 1.5 miles** (family/beginner) – grid C3
Connects the internal trails of Cool Creek Park to Westfield.
 - **Northwest Border Loop – 33.3 miles** (expert) – grid A1
Westfield's longest loop is filled with enough obstacles to give it an expert rating. It is very long, hilly, and entirely on paved roads. Points of interest: Grand Park
- Express Routes:** These routes run north/south and east/west, and direct cyclists and commuters from one side of the county to the other.



MONON TRAIL

Located in Carmel and Westfield this trail will connect you with City Center, the Carmel Arts & Design District and Grand Park.

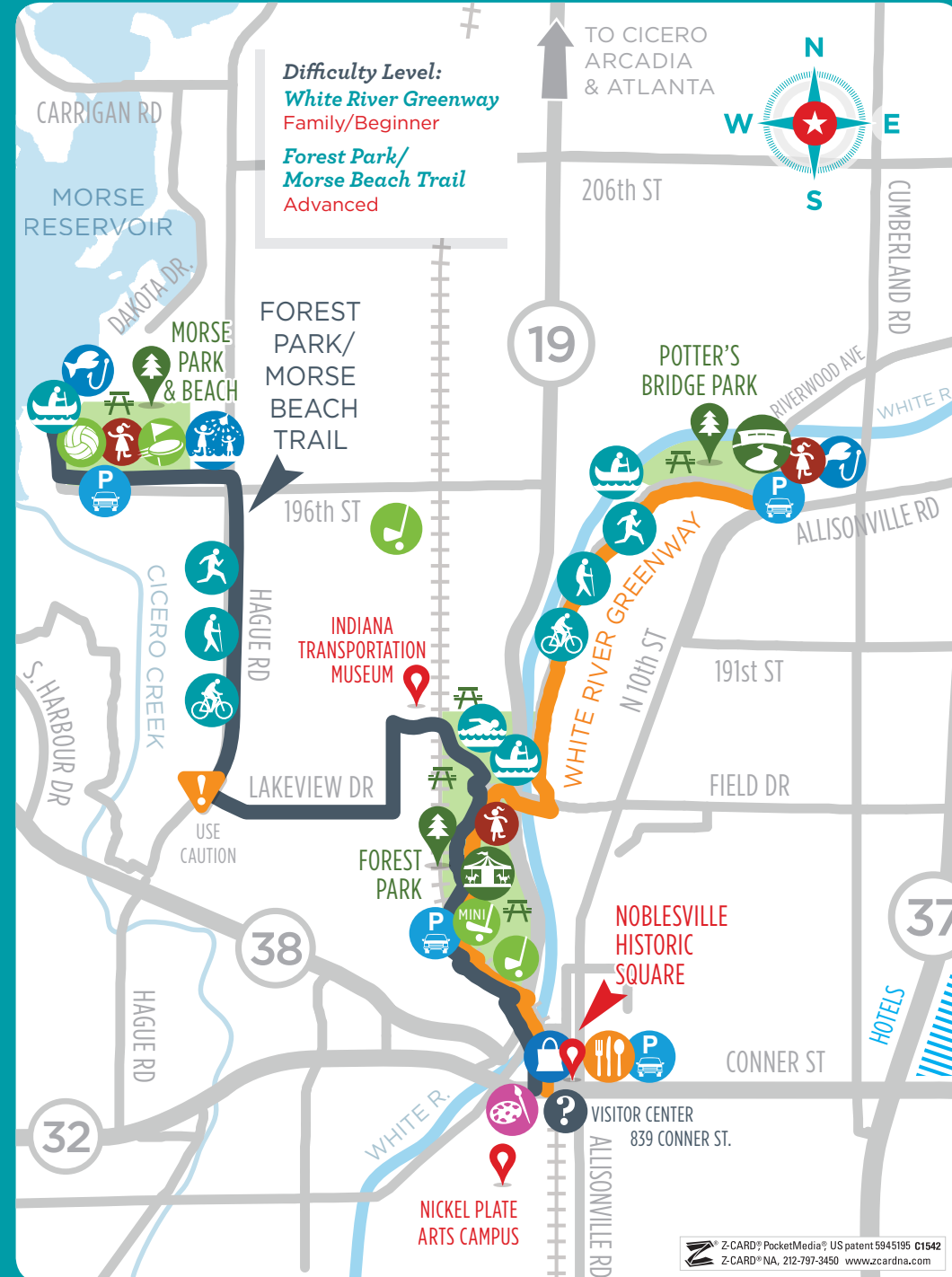
