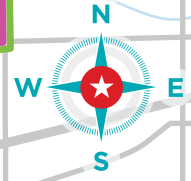

• **Deer Creek Loop - 10.5 miles** (family/beginner)

Points of interest: Promise Road Elementary, Klipsch Music Center, Hamilton Town Center, Stonycreek Golf Club, Sagamore Golf Club

• **Dillon Park Loop - 8.2 miles** (family/beginner)

Points of interest: Hazel Dell Elementary, Noble Crossing Elementary, Dillon Park, Midland Trace

• **Morse Reservoir Loop - 9.3 miles** (family/beginner)

Points of interest: Morse Beach Park, Hague Road Park, Hinkle Creek Elementary

• **White River Loop - 12.6 miles** (advanced)

Points of interest: White River Canoe Launch, Potter's Bridge Park

*Loop Difficulty Level*

**FAMILY/BEGINNER** - Suitable for children. Flat, easy rides on dedicated trail or neighborhood roads.

**ADVANCED** - Obstacles may include difficult road crossings, hills, and a lack of shoulder or sidewalk along road.

**EXPRESS ROUTES** - These routes run north/south and east/west, and direct cyclists and commuters from one side of the county to the other.
