<b>About the Center</b>	Opened in 1998, the Hawai'i Convention Center is Hawai'i's largest meetings facility. Conveniently located 8 miles from the Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, near 28,000 guest rooms, as well as shopping, dining and entertainment venues
<b>Features</b>	Designed with a Hawaiian "sense of place" by Hawai'i-based architecture firm Wimberly Allison Tong & Goo (WAT&G) and LMN Architects.
<b>Specifications</b>	Spanning 1.1 million sq. ft., the center is divided for ease of use, including exhibition space, parking facilities, meeting rooms and ballrooms – each on its own floor
<b>Exhibit Hall</b>	More than 200,000 sq. ft. exhibition hall with drive-on floor access and 350 pounds per square foot floor load capacity
