

James P. Davis Hall, in beautiful Wyandotte County Lake Park, is maintained by the Parks and Recreation Department of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City Kansas. It is just one of several reservation facilities that are available in the park system.

Davis Hall was completed in 1937 through a WPA project along with the lake and the park. All of the lumber and stone came from park property and was cut by hand. The wood inside is black walnut and oak. The capacity for Davis Hall is 150 people and it is our most popular rental facility for weddings and receptions.
