Swamp Tours

Ranger programs, films, exhibits, and events share a variety of local traditions including music, story-telling, dance, and food, and explore the mysteries of the Atchafalaya Basin, Louisiana's wildest place. St. John's Cathedral Self-Guided Tour

The Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist in Downtown Lafayette stands as a Dutch Romanesque landmark, completed in 1916 and is on the National Registry of Historic Properties. Enjoy the beauty of the Cathedral, the 500-year-old Cathedral Oak, the Cathedral Cemetery, Cathedral Museum and Gift Shop as well as Presepio Exhibit of 18th century Nativity figures from Naples, Italy. Brewery Tastings & Tours

Parish Brewing Company

Enjoy the local flavor of Lafayette's craft beer at Parish Brewing in Broussard. Parish beer is brewed right here in Lafayette Parish using old-school techniques with German, Belgian, and North American malted barley and other grains and the finest hops from the Pacific Northwest and Europe. Visit their tap room to sample their latest brews or stop in on the weekend and get a free tour of the brewery. (ParishBeer.com)

Bayou Teche Brewing

Bayou Teche Brewery located in Arnaudville brings together the fine art of craft brewing and the culinary traditions of Cajun culture. What started as creating a beer that would pair well with Cajun cuisine has evolved into a brewery and tap room that hosts events showcasing the unique food, music and beer of Cajun Country. Best time to stop by is on a Saturday where you can taste their latest creations in the tap room, get a free tour of the brewery and listen to a Cajun jam on the porch. (BayouTecheBrewing.com)

Cajun Brewing

Cajun Brewing, opened in October 2015. Their initial line of products includes three beer varieties: Cajun WIT, Ragin' Red Ale and Brown Ale. Future plans include guided tours of the brewery and brewing process as well as a tap room where visitors can sample test batches and get a taste of new beers. (CajunBrewing.com)

Cypress Lake & Lake Martin

If you're looking to get a view of South Louisiana's unique wildlife and landscapes swing by the beautiful Cypress Lake on the campus of University of Louisiana at Lafayette. You will see swampland, cypress trees, alligators, turtles, fish, birding and so much more. If you have enough time in your schedule make a trip to immerse yourself at Lake Martin.

Lafayette Farmers and Artisans Market at the Horse Farm

Experience the beauty of one of the largest green space parks in Lafayette while shopping and supporting local farmers and artisans. With local food vendors, artisans, jam sessions, park tours and educational seminars, it's a great way to spend a Saturday. The park and farmer's market is open every Saturday rain or shine from 8 a.m. – 12 p.m. (MarketAtTheHorseFarm.com)

La Maison de Begnaud

The Begnaud House located in Scott is nestled between a walking trail and Scott's Arboretum. The Acadian style home houses a library with collections of the city's history and memorabilia, a heritage interpretive room that serves as a teaching area and screening rooming, a small souvenir and gift shop as well as a Cajun jam every Friday night. Sans Souci Fine Craft Gallery

The Sans Souci Fine Crafts Gallery features the work of local artisans in a variety of mediums including pottery, jewelry, glass, textiles, metal and wood. The 1,200-square-foot facility adjacent to Parc Sans Souci is one of Lafayette's oldest structures, built between 1885 and 1886. The space was restored in 2001 to house the works of the Louisiana Craft Guild members. (LouisianaCrafts.org)

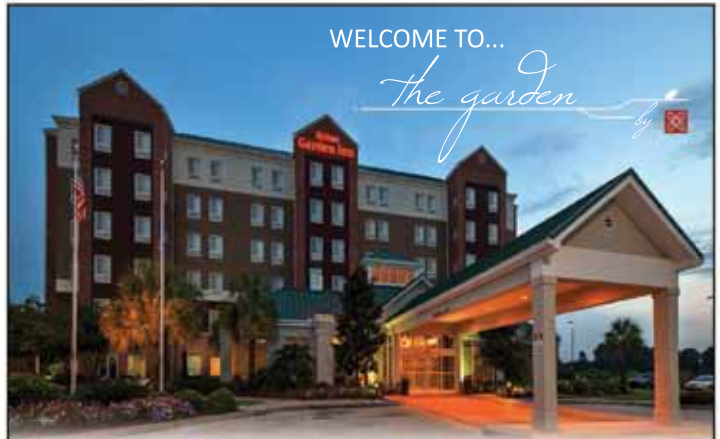

CHITIMACHA MUSEUM

Take a trip through the history of the Chitimacha Tribe, this region's first inhabitants, at this free museum. The Chitimacha ("People of the many waters") were known for their basket weaving artistry and the museum features artifacts and brief videos.

FRANKLIN HISTORIC DISTRICT/ MAIN STREET

A walking tour is a must for lovers of historic architecture and the Old South. On the National Register of Historic Places, the Franklin Historic District boasts more than 420 noteworthy structures, including stunning antebellum homes under a live oak arcade, charming Victorian cottages and a late-19th-century downtown shopping district.

LOUISIANA STATE MUSEUM -PATTERSON

Explore the exhibits of the Louisiana State Museum-Patterson. The Wedell-Williams Aviation Museum offers numerous aircraft, 1930s air race trophies and memorabilia, as well as a children's exhibit. Cypress Sawmill exhibits document the history of the cypress lumber industry in our area.

MORGAN CITY HISTORIC DISTRICT RIVERFRONT

Explore this city's unique waterfront, with its seawall, shops and restaurants, all close to several other attractions and historic homes and churches in the district.

INTERNATIONAL PETROLEUM MUSEUM AND EXPOSITION

Walk aboard an authentic offshore drilling rig, the "Mr. Charlie," the centerpiece of a unique facility which also offers training for the offshore oil industry. On a guided tour, visitors will learn about the oil industry, the functions of the oil rig and hear tales of the industry's beginnings.

CYPRESS BAYOU CASINO

Try your luck at Louisiana's first land-based casino, on the Chitimacha Indian Reservation in Charenton. Over 1350 slot machines and more than 50 table games (including blackjack, craps, roulette, three and four card poker) are featured.

There is also a live action poker room, off-track betting, seven restaurants and a nightclub with entertainment every weekend plus national acts.

OAKLAWN MANOR

Tour this 1837 Greek Revival plantation manor, the residence of Louisiana's former governor and Mrs. Murphy J. (Mike) Foster. The home features European antiques, lovely bird carvings and an extensive Audubon collection.

GREVEMBERG HOUSE

Visit an authentically-restored 1851 Greek Revival style townhouse, which is on the National Register of Historic Places. Four "Temple of the Winds" Corinthian columns grace the home, containing fine antiques, documented wallpapers and early artifacts.

CAJUN CAVIAR SWAMP TOURS

Sit back, relax and let Cajun Caviar guide you in exploring the natural beauty of the Atchafalaya Basin. Learn about the Cajun culture—fur trapping, crabbing and crawfishing—on tours lasting approximately 2 1/2 hours.

AMELIA BELLE CASINO
