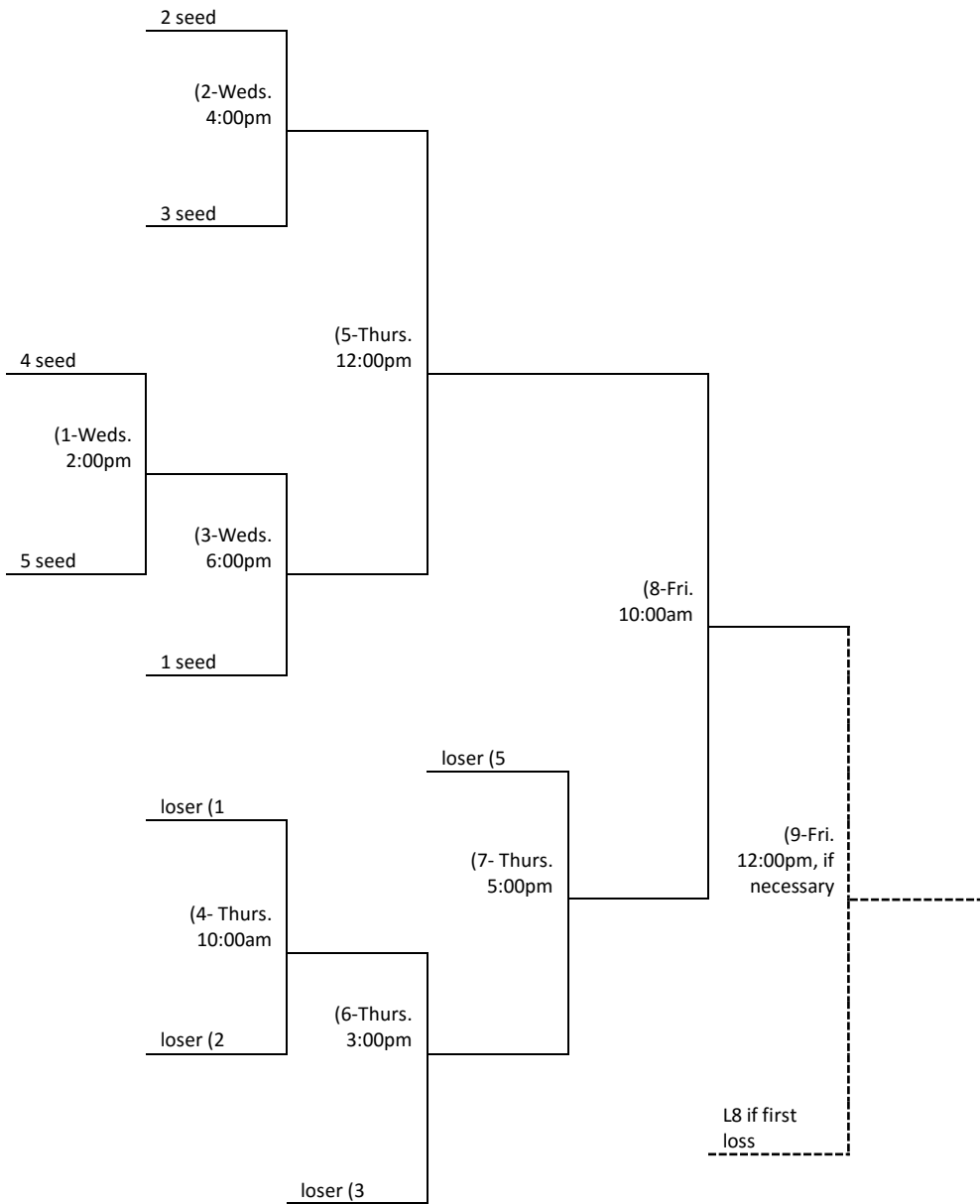

Entry Fee

Once the teams qualify for this tournament (see Region XII Regulations for qualifying requirements), please process the Entry Fee of \$550.00 (Attachment 2 is an invoice) made out to Lansing Community College and mailed to:

Per the Region XII Regulations: the tournament director must receive notice of non-participation within 14 calendar days prior to the tournament. Once a team has qualified for this tournament, they are obligated to pay the entry fee, whether they attend or not. Entry fees must be paid before the tournament starts.

Region XII Coaches Meeting

The NJCAA recommends conducting a regional meeting at all region tournaments to conduct regional business and voting for All-Region and All-American nominations. **All statistics must be up-to-date on the NJCAA website for All-Region and All-American consideration.** It is mandatory that each institution within the region that participates in this specific sport have a representative at the regional meeting.

This Region XII meeting will be held Wednesday, May 10, 2014 in the Gannon Building Room 480. This meeting will start approximately 8:30p.m. or as soon as possible after the 6:00p.m. game ends. Please refer to **Attachment 2** for the specific map and location of the coaches meeting on the main campus of Lansing Community College.

The Region XII Regulations are below for the specific All-Region voting procedures:

ALL REGION XII TEAM SELECTION

- A. An 18 player All-Region Team will be selected by a vote of the softball coaches.
- B. Top vote getting players from the OCCAC, MCCAAC-West, and MCCAAC-East will be represented on the All-Region Team.
 1. The MCCAAC-West and MCCAAC-East top seven (7) All-Conference vote getters and the OCCAC top four (4) vote getters will receive automatic All-Region awards.
- C. The proportions will be reviewed each spring at the coaches meeting.

ALL AMERICAN SELECTIONS

- A. All-American nominations must be submitted to the Region Director at the Region XII Coaches Meeting. All-American selections must have been already selected to the All-Region Team. Coaches may speak on behalf of their nominations at the Region XII Coaches Meeting.
- B. The Region Director will develop a ballot of the region's All-American nominees and distribute this ballot at the coaches meeting. The coaches will vote for the designated number of players according to the national Office guidelines. Coaches may vote for their own players.
- C. The Region Director will forward the region's nominees to the National Softball Committee Chairperson by the stated deadline on the All-American Nomination Form.

Tournament Specific Rules and Tournament Play

Tournament Play

All games will be seven innings in duration (except for mercy rules), except the championship games (games 8, 9) which will be seven innings (without mercy rules).

The NCAA rules will apply except for the following exceptions:

1. The halted game rule will be in effect for all national tournament play.
2. The international tiebreaker will not be used in national tournament play.
3. The eight-run rule will not be in effect for the tournament championship game(s).

Any protest must be made on location with the game being stopped for immediate ruling from the Tournament Director. Any protest being lodged after play has resumed, shall not be accepted or considered.

The highest seed will remain the home team throughout the tournament.

Practice Schedule (Pre-Game Practice)

Pre-game practice will be allowed on half of the diamond (both teams share) if time permits between games. We will start all tournament games on time if possible.

Roster Information / Team Photograph

All roster information and team photographs will be accessed from the MCCA & OCCAC websites. Make sure all photographs and rosters are up-to-date with your league SID for proper representation in the Tournament Program.

T-Shirt Ordering

Uniforms

Each team must bring two sets of jerseys (&/or uniforms) of different colors. The NJCAA representative &/or Tournament Director will make the final decision if additional uniforms are not available and the coaches do not agree on uniform colors.

Awards

At the conclusion of the Region XII Softball Championship, there will be an awards ceremony. The following awards will be presented: Runner-up individual awards, Runner-up Trophy, Champion individual awards, Champion Trophy, Region XII Coach-of-the-Year, All-Tournament Team individual awards, Tournament Most Valuable Player.

Per the NJCAA Regulations, there are 18 individual awards per team for the runner-up and champion. If you need to order additional individual awards have your athletic director work with the NJCAA through your Region XII Director.

Tournament Program

Tournament programs will be available and for sale at the venue.

Ticket Information

Admission to the tournament will be free of charge.

Bench Area / Passes

Only team related personnel are allowed on the bench and in the dugout area. The Site Director &/or Tournament Director may ask for identification and removal of non-team personnel from the dugout area.

Training Room and Medical Information

Athletic trainers will be on site a minimum of two hours prior to all game times. There is not a Training Room on site. If you have any special needs, please contact our Tournament Athletic Trainer: Kyle Knapp @ Cell: 248.890.8413.

It is expected that each team bring training supplies (tape, wraps, sleeves, other needs) with them. The host institution is not responsible for training / medical supplies.

All teams are requested to bring their own training and First Aid supplies along with **one water cooler** and towels. Please fill your cooler with ice before you leave for the field each day. Ice will **not** be provided.

Transportation / Travel Information

All transportation arrangements will be the responsibility of the participating team.

Coach of the Year

The Coach of the Year Award will be awarded to the head coach of the Region XII district championship team per the Region XII Regulations.

Attachment 1

REGION XII WOMEN'S DIVISION REGULATION SOFTBALL-DIVISION II

I. CODE OF CONDUCT

- A. The NJCAA Code of Conduct (Article XX) and the NJCAA Sportsmanship Policy (Article XVIII) will apply to all Region XII contests.

II. QUALIFYING POLICY

- A. Any school having to forfeit 50% or more of their conference games due to NJCAA or State Association sanctions and/or has not qualified by the conclusion of the last regular season conference game played will not be allowed to participate in post season play.

III. DRESS DECORUM

- A. Game attire for all bench personnel, other than uniformed players, must be a college issued warm-up suit or business casual apparel unless weather does not permit. All other team personnel must wear appropriate institutional collared shirts, shorts &/or slacks (no denim/jeans), shoes and socks (no sandals, flip-flops). Headgear must be worn in an appropriate manner. No changing into game uniforms at the bench area. Teams must use locker room or restroom facilities away from the public.

IV. SOFTBALL REGULATIONS - REGULAR SEASON

- A. All games are to be played in accordance with the official NCAA rules; with the exceptions noted here:
 - 1. An eight (8)-run mercy rule shall be used for all Region XII non-championship games.
 - 2. Tiebreaker will not be used in Region XII games.
 - 3. Pre-game, if conditions allow, will be the following:
 - a. Each team will have a maximum of 10 minutes on the game field.
 - b. The home team will have the choice of taking infield first or second.
 - c. The first team shall have the field from 2:35 to 2:45 on weekday games and 12:35 to 12:45 on weekend games. The second team shall have the field from 2:45 to 2:55 for weekday games and from 12:45 to 12:55 on weekend games. The pre-game meeting will commence at home plate at 2:55 for weekday games and 12:55 for weekend games.
- B. The home team will be responsible for the following:
 - 1. Official scorebook.
 - 2. Payment of two qualified NCAA registered umpires (may be neither a student nor employee of the college).
 - 3. A minimum of four balls per doubleheader. The official softball shall be the official ball as declared by the NJCAA.
 - 4. Providing of water to the visiting team bench. Ice availability is recommended (for the treatment of injuries).
 - 5. A list of approved officials and phone numbers must be at the game site.
 - 6. A copy of the NCAA rulebook.
 - 7. Medical First Responder or Athletic Trainer on site.
- C. All teams are to provide rosters and team pictures to the MCAA/OCCAC/Region XII Publicity Director by the date prescribed.

V. SOFTBALL REGION TOURNAMENT

- A. Tournament site:
 - 1. A single site to be awarded for a period of two years at a time, to be selected by the Region Athletic Directors at the Spring Meeting. The site and entry fees will be determined by bid.
 - 2. Factors to be considered in site selection:

- a. The number and quality of playing diamonds
- b. Lighted fields
- c. Shower and locker facilities
- d. Seating facilities
- e. Availability of college-quality officials
- f. Suitable eating and lodging facilities
- g. Geographic suitability of the site
- h. Regulation fields must be provided with official fast pitch home run fences. The fences may be temporary fences.

B. Team Selection:

- 1. Teams will qualify for each District Championship. The teams will be determined by a proportional representation from each conference. If a district has less than five (5) teams entered, the brackets will be adjusted accordingly.

C. Entries:

- 1. Make sure rosters and team pictures are available (sent or on league web sites).
- 2. The tournament director must receive notice of non-participation 14 calendar days prior to the tournament.
- 3. Once a team has signed a confirmation of entry form, they are obligated to pay the entry fee, whether they attend or not. Entry fees must be paid before the tournament starts.

D. Tournament Structure:

- 1. The District Tournaments will be a seeded, five (5) team, double-elimination tournaments.
- 2. Their conference finish using their respective conference tie-breaking procedures will seed teams.
- 3. Seeding-Both District I and J will be seeded the same way

- 4. In odd years when OCCAC is the #1 seed, the OCCAC representative must be the OCCAC Champion. If not, the other rotation will be used.
- 5. If the OCCAC does not send a representative to the District Tournament and they are not the number one seed, all seeds will move up one spot and another MCCA A team will fill in at the bottom. The rotations would move on as normal.

E. Awards:

- 1. First place team trophy and 18 individual awards for each district.
- 2. Second place team trophy and 18 individual awards for each district.
- 3. All-Tournament Team awards:
 - a. A nine-player All-Tournament Team will receive individual awards.
 - b. Three impartial judges appointed by the Tournament Director will select this team.
 - c. The cost of these awards will be a tournament expense.

G. Officials:

- 1. Will be selected by the Tournament Director with input from the southern playing schools to ensure proper representation.

2. The officials will be NCAA certified.
- H. Duties of the Tournament Manager:
1. Be responsible for the playing site.
 2. Be responsible for pre-game and post-game publicity.
 3. Be responsible for attracting and scheduling quality umpires.
 4. Be responsible for providing each competing team with information relating to opponents, site, time, meals, lodging, etc. (use approved Softball Region XII Tournament Manual as a guide).
 5. Be responsible for making decisions about game postponement prior to the start of a game.
 6. Be responsible for making the decision regarding changing the tournament from double elimination to single elimination based on inclement weather conditions.
 7. All protests will be answered immediately by the tournament manager or by person(s) designated by him/her.
 8. Be responsible for handling any other problems that arise concerning the tournament.
 9. In case of rain, the tournament will be extended if necessary. Championship games will be played to their conclusion.

VI. ALL REGION XII TEAM SELECTION

- A. An 18 player All-Region Team will be selected by a vote of the softball coaches.
- B. Top vote getting players from the OCCAC, MCCA West, and MCCA East will be represented on the All-Region Team.
 1. The MCCA West and MCCA East top seven (7) All-Conference vote getters and the OCCAC top four (4) vote getters will receive automatic All-Region awards.
- C. The proportions will be reviewed each spring at the coaches meeting.

VII. ALL AMERICAN SELECTIONS

- A. All-American nominations must be submitted to the Region Director at the Region XII Coaches Meeting. All-American selections must have been already selected to the All-Region Team. Coaches may speak on behalf of their nominations at the Region XII Coaches Meeting.
- B. The Region Director will develop a ballot of the region's All-American nominees and distribute this ballot at the coaches meeting. The coaches will vote for the designated number of players according to the national Office guidelines. Coaches may vote for their own players.
- C. The Region Director will forward the region's nominees to the National Softball Committee Chairperson by the stated deadline on the All-American Nomination Form.

VIII. COACH OF THE YEAR

- A. The Coach of the Year will be the coach of each District Champion.

IX. NATIONAL RATINGS

- A. Follow the NJCAA directions to nominate teams each week within the timelines established by the NJCAA.

X. MISCELLANEOUS

- A. Use of Tobacco Prohibited:
 1. The use of tobacco products by any coach, player, official or other individual involved in the conducting of any NJCAA sanctioned or sponsored regular season or post-season play is prohibited within the confines of the playing area. Any individual not in compliance shall be disqualified from further participation in that contest.
