



Michigan Avenue (Capitol Loop) Bridge Improvements

Lansing, Ingham County: June 4 - Sept. 30, 2018

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will invest about \$600,000 in preventive maintenance and repair work on the Michigan Avenue (Capitol Loop) bridge over the Grand River in the city of Lansing.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Stage 1 (June 4 - late June):

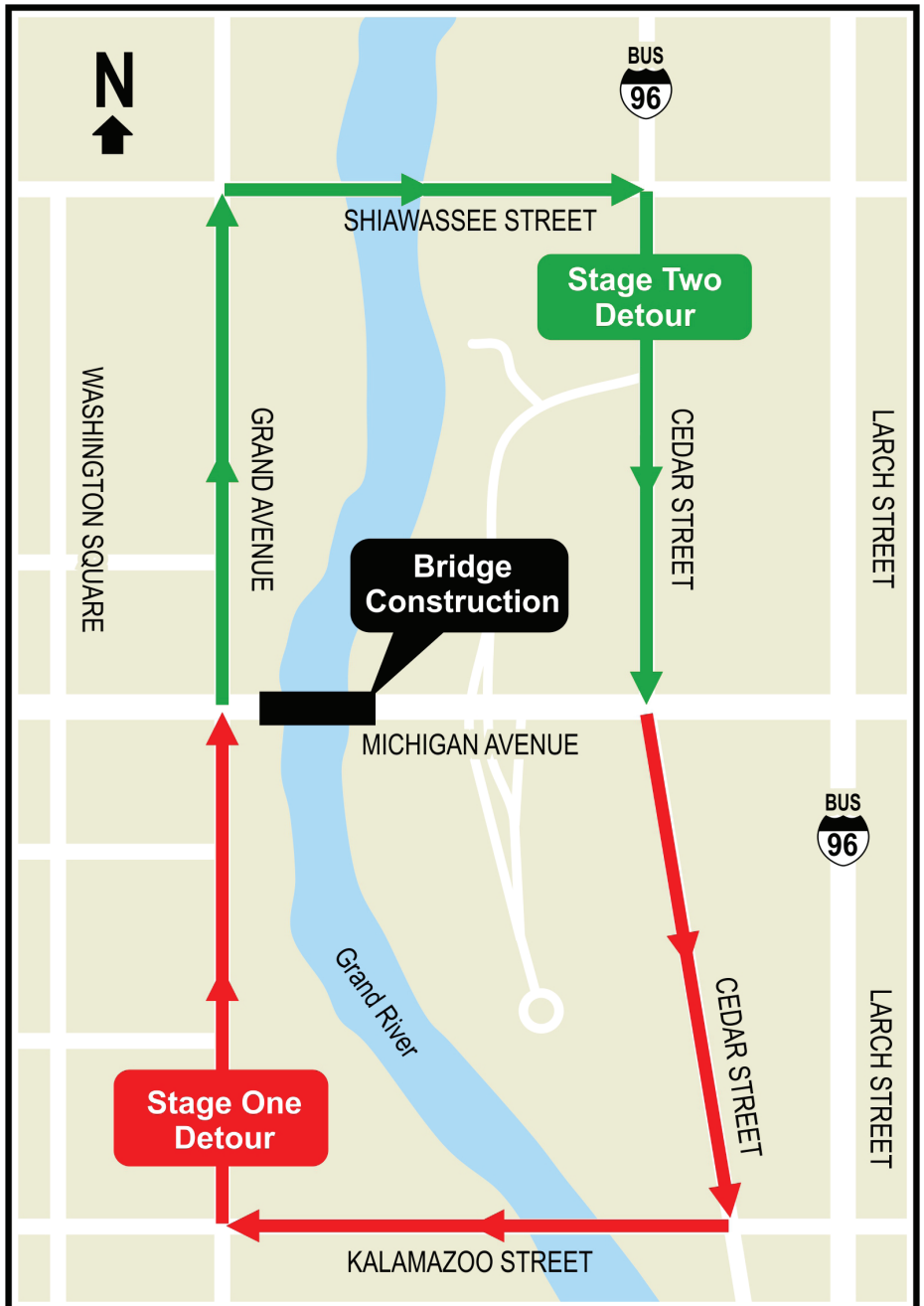
Work will occur on the north half of the bridge with all westbound lanes closed. Posted detour: Cedar Street to Kalamazoo Street, then Grand Avenue (beginning to end of June).

Stage 2 (Late June - Mid-August):

Work will occur on the south half of the bridge with all eastbound lanes closed. Posted detour: Grand Avenue to Shiawassee Street, then Cedar Street.

Work will be suspended during the Common Ground Music Festival and the 4th of July holiday, with the eastbound lanes closed.

At the end of the summer, the bridge will be closed for one weekend with posted detours following the previous routes listed.
