

MGM Resorts NBA Summer League

The MGM Resorts NBA Summer League returns to Las Vegas for the sixth consecutive year, July 6–17, at Thomas & Mack Center and Cox Pavilion. It's expected to attract more than 132,000 attendees for an estimated \$57.1 million total economic impact.

A featured matchup between the top two picks in this year's NBA Draft highlights the 12-day, 82-game event featuring top rookies from the NBA Draft and young players from across the league.

For the first time in NBA Summer League's history, all 30 NBA teams will be featured in Las Vegas, and the play tips off with a record 10 games on Friday, July 6. Every Summer League game will air live on television, with ESPN networks and NBA TV combining to televise a record number of games (and streamed live on the mobile app).

The matchup between the Phoenix Suns and Sacramento Kings on Saturday, July 7, will feature the top two picks in Deandre Ayton and Marvin Bagley III at 7:30 p.m. Eastern Time. The MGM Resorts NBA Summer League game will be aired live on ESPN.

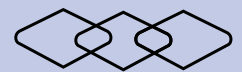
The tournament-style format will culminate with the Championship Game on July 17 at 10 p.m. ET on ESPN. Each team will play a minimum of five games, starting with three preliminary contests July 6–10. The teams will then be seeded in the tournament, which starts on July 11.
