DENVER'S ON THE RIGHT TRACK!

A massive restoration and expansion of Denver's majestic Union Station and the surrounding area – 13 buildings covering up to four million square feet – will be unveiled in July. Transforming the area into a transportation, dining, shopping and entertainment hub, it will include the new 112-room Crawford Hotel, four restaurants, two fast-food outlets, ten one-of-a-kind-boutiques and two new parks. www.unionstationdenver.com.

BIKE SHARING IN PHILADELPHIA

Philadelphia expects a flurry of cyclists during late summer, when the city's new Bike Share programme is launched. Visitors can choose from more than 50 bike stations, cycling to such attractions as the new Venice Island in Philadelphia's

concert at the Tarara Winery near Leesburg.

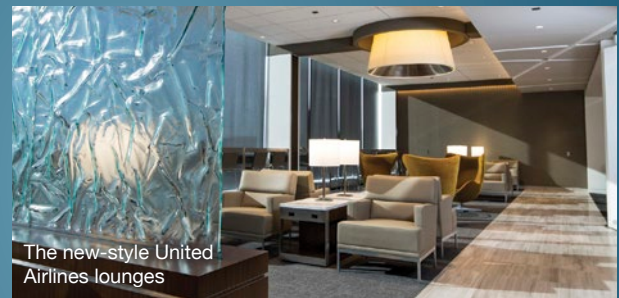
