DANE COUNTY CAMPGROUNDS

Babcock County Park

Babcock Park is located on the east side of Lake Waubesa at the outflow of the Yahara River, near the Village of McFarland. The park has a 25-unit campground with electricity, as well as a fully-accessible bathroom and shower.

Lake Farm Park

This 328-acre park has three shelter facilities, play equipment, boat launch, wildlife point and overlook tower. There are 54 sites, including 39 electrical hookups for RVs, bathroom and shower facilities.

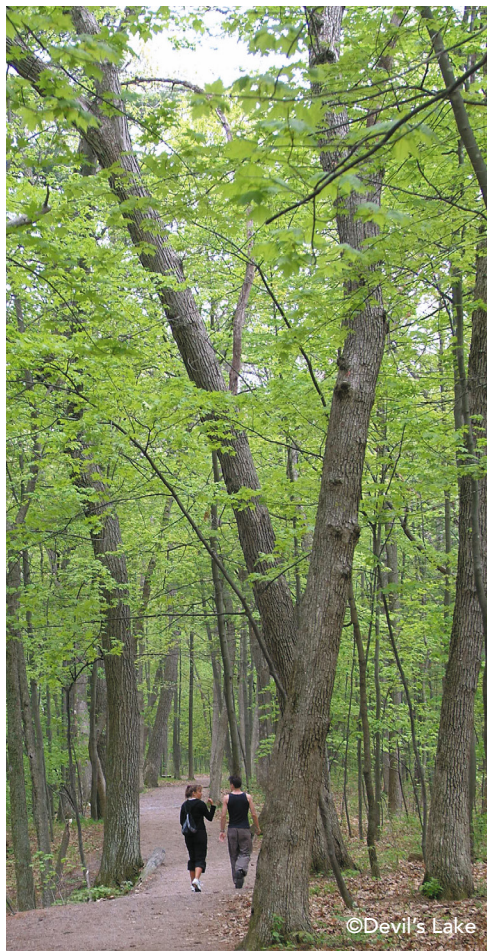
