## WEATHER

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation offers current weather and road condition information through their website (http://www.511wi.gov/Web) or by calling 511 on your phone. This is an easy way to see if major highways are snow covered or slippery throughout the state, and the website also has detailed city traffic information on Madison - you can view road conditions through traffic cameras, see what projected travel times will be, or get alerts on recent accidents.

### SAFETY

Madison is regularly ranked as one of the safest cities to live in the country, but it is still an urban environment where it's smart to be alert and aware of your surroundings. Below are a few tips on protecting yourself. Please be careful and be safe!

- Never walk alone, especially at night.
- Carry a cell phone and dial 911 for help if you feel threatened.
- Always make sure your hotel room is locked, and use the security chain when you are in the room.
- Don't let anyone you don't know into your hotel room.
- If you plan to drink, do so in moderation.
- Keep your head up when walking. Walk purposefully and project confidence.
- Use public walkways and avoid isolated shortcuts.
- If you think someone is following you, cross the street. At night, head for a wellpopulated and well-lit area.
- Wear comfortable clothing and shoes that will allow you maximum mobility.
- Immediately report any suspicious people to the police.
