## Day 1

Enjoy nature trails and examine wildlife habitats at this center for environmental education. Then we will depart for shopping. Shop one-of-a-kind Miss Cayce's Christmas Store for holiday decorations and ornaments. Purchase Mexican imports at Way Out West Trading Post. Depart for dinner and entertainment. Enjoy a Texas steak dinner at the Cattle Baron Steakhouse. Depart for the historic Yucca Theatre. Throw popcorn and enjoy sidesplitting laughter during the Olio of Summer Mummers melodrama mayhem (June through Labor Day).

## Day 3

Check out of the hotel and depart for **Scarborough-Linebery House**. Enjoy tea and scones in the beautiful backyard of this Historical Texas Medallion Home with a tour of the interior. Depart for **Susie's South Forty Confections candy factory** to have some coffee and toffee with a demonstration on candy making. Lunch at Southern Velle for authentic southern home cooking such as fried green tomatoes filled with cream cheese. Then we will depart for the **Monahans Sandhills State Park** where there is nearly 4,000 acres of wind-sculpted sand dunes, some up to 70 feet high. Giant Frisbees can be rented to slide down the hills. Then on to Fort Stockton where we will tour the **Historic Fort** and see the world's largest roadrunner. We will end the day with a picnic dinner and optional evening stroll. Overnight in Fort Stockton.
