HOW TO TRAVELLIKE A LOCAL

STAY SAFE Be mindful of your surroundings with these quick tips:

- Pull off the road in legal areas for photographs and stay alert to other drivers and pedestrians.
- Enjoy local wine and beer responsibly with a designated driver, hired transport or public transportation.
- Check hiking trails before embarking to ensure that you can traverse them safely.
- Keep out of closed parks, trails and private property.
- Build campfires only in designated spaces and follow proper protocol when putting them out.
- Stay at least 200 feet away from wildlife.
- Face the ocean when you are near and only enter in safe, marked locations. Keep watch for sweeping waves and riptides.

PROTECT & CONSERVE Together, we can preserve our lands, seas and wildlife.

- Stay on designated trails to protect yourself and native plant life.
- Conserve water when washing your hands, showering and brushing your teeth.
- Dispose of waste, recyclables and cigarette butts in designated receptacles.
- Pick up loose trash to leave the land better than you found it.
- Turn off lights and electronics when leaving your room for the day.
- Find sustainable seafood through the Monterey Bay Aquarium Seafood Watch program.



PLAN AHEAD Local travel suggestions for your convenience and comfort.

- Locate public restrooms and parking before venturing out.
- Bring reusable bags and water bottles to save money and protect the environment.
- Learn whether your destination is pet-friendly before bringing a furry friend.
- Double-check opening and closing times at restaurants and attractions to arrive on time.
- Book ahead to secure a safe, legal campsite for your tent or RV.
- Find nearby car charging stations on our website.
- Stop by the Monterey Visitors Center to learn about attractions throughout the county.
