Contest Details and Guidelines:

The Nacogdoches CVB invites you to "Capture Nacogdoches" by participating in our official 2018 photography contest. Entries will be accepted Monday, Aug. 27, through Friday, Sept. 28. A maximum of two entries may be submitted per person. All photographs must be taken in Nacogdoches County and fall into a designated category. (See below.) Photos submitted will be displayed during a reception Thursday, Oct. 4, at the Charles Bright Visitor Center. Winners will be announced at that time.

Submission Categories:

History Downtown
Nature SFA
Culture Nightlife
Young Photographer (Under 18)

Prizes:

First place - \$250
Second place - \$100
Third place - \$50

Photos should be edited to a 300 DPI resolution and must be 8x10 when printed. Photos must be current. Minimal editing is allowed but may not be used to manipulate or include anything that does not naturally occur in the scene. Photos must be adhered to an 11x14 black mat. (Mats of this kind are available at Hobby Lobby for minimal cost.) No frames. Upon submission, you will be required to fill out a form with your information and descriptions of your submissions. Forms are available at the Charles Bright Visitor center or online at www.VisitNacogdoches.org/photo.

To Do before the Contest Deadline:

- 1.) Email digital copies of your submissions to Stephanie@VisitNacogdoches.org
- 2.) Bring matted copies of submissions and completed entry forms to the Charles Bright Visitor Center. A jury will judge all submissions. Three overall winners will be selected to win the cash prizes noted above. Winners will be announced during the Oct. 4 reception.

Submissions with any of the following will be deemed ineligible:

- Photos of captive animals photographed in commercial game farms.
- Photos that violate or infringe upon a person's rights, including but not limited to copyright.
- Photos that contain sexually explicit, nude, obscene or violent imagery.
- Photos that involve putting an animal in danger.
