Economic Impact

Tourism is one of the most influential drivers of New Mexico's economy

- In 2015, 34 million visitors came to New Mexico - an increase of nearly 700,000 from 2014.
- Visitor spending has increased for six consecutive years, reaching \$6.3 billion in 2015.
- Tourism generated \$4.7
 billion in state GDP in 2015—
 5% of the total New Mexico economy.
- Room demand continues to grow, increasing by 2.1% in 2015.

- Tax revenue from tourism
 reached \$629 million in state and
 local taxes in 2015. Taxes and fees
 combined totaled \$1.3 billion in
 2015. These tax dollars go to
 federal, state and local
 governments to help fund jobs
 and public programs such as
 police, firefighters, teachers, road
 projects and convention centers.
- Halo effect research shows that exposure to New Mexico and tourism campaigns positively influences perceptions of living and working in our state.
- In 2015, local transportation and lodging spending growth outpaced overall spending growth.
